Thursday June 24th Begins with strong Gales from the S.W. laying too under a close Reef (M. top sail and fore spencer middle part the same at day light made sail and stored E.S.E. so Ends

Friday June 25th Commences with fresh Breezes from the S.W. steering E.S.E. Cloudy hazy weather middle part the same latter part light winds saw Blackbird lowered did not get on so Ends
