E. at 6 A.M. made sail at 10 A.M. close Reef top sails squally with a Rough sea so Ends

Wednesday June 22nd Commences with thick squally weather with thunder and lightning from the S. W. standing to the S. E. at 4 P.M. split the fore top sail took in the fore top sail and fore sail and hove too middle part the same latter part more moderate made sail under the fore top sail to Repair found the fore top sail yard sprung sent it down to fish so Ends

Thursday June 29th Begins with fresh Brees from the S.W. and clear weather standing to the S.E. fished the yard and sent it aloft found it rotten at sun set shortened sail heading to the Northward at day Bent the fore top sail wore sh. to the S.E. and made sail so Ends started 11.4 Day 14 Oct

Saturday July 3rd Begins with light winds from the Eastward standing to the Northward at 2 P.M. saw whales and landed and the Starboard Boat struck the whale Run bad and sounded we could not get on to kill him at sun set cut and come Aboard shortened sail middle part calm latter part light Breeze from the Eastward saw Blackfish 7 or 8 fathoms started 1 cask of Molasses so Ends
