

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

Sunday July 4th 1841 Begins with light winds from the Eastward standing to the Northward at 12 P.M. tacked to the Southward and shortened sail made fast the same at day light made sail at 7 P.M. tacked to the Northward one sail in sight so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 32.25 N. Long. 44.05 West

Monday July 5th Begins with fresh Breezes from the E.S.E. and clear weather at 12 M. tacked to the South at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail latter steering North so Ends started 1 P.M. Bree

Latt. By Obs. 32.02 N. Long. 44.07 W

Tuesday July 6th Commences with fresh Breezes from the Eastward clear weather steering west at sun set shortened sail and hauled N.E. middle part the same latter part made sail steering North at 10 A.M. steered West so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 32.06 N. Long. 44.36 W

Wednesday July 7th Begins with light winds from the East. and fine weather steering west at sun set shortened sail and hauled to the S.E. at day light made sail and steered N.W. at 8 A.M. steered North so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 31.51 N. Long. 45.30 W

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Thursday July 8th 1841 Begins with light winds and clear weather standing to the Northward at sun set shortened sail heading to the S.E. at day light made sail at 10 A.M. tacked to the North wind variable so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 31.57 N. Long. 44.49 West

Friday July 9th Begins with light winds and variable squally weather heading various courses at sun set shortened sail to the Northward at day light made sail steering North so Ends 1 man sick

Latt. By Obs. 32.38 N. Long. 44.23

Saturday July 10th Commences with light winds from the Eastward steering North at sun set shortened sail middle part squally with thunder and lightning and Rain at 9 A.M. made sail and steering North wind from the S.E. squally so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 33.23 N. Long. 44.50 West

Sunday July the 11th Begins with fresh winds from East. squally steering North at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail steering North so Ends 1 man sick

Latt. By Obs. 34.39 N. Long. 45.18 West

Monday July 12 Begins with strong winds from the Eastward steering North at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail and to the N.E. so Ends 1 man sick

Latt. By Obs. 35.51 N. Long. 45.18 W
