Tuesday July the 13th. Commences with strong winds from S. E. standing to the N. E. quite to port to the East latter part the same so Ends 1 man sick

Wednesday July the 14th. Begins with fresh winds from the South and clear weather standing to the Eastward at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail and stood to the westward spoke the Pilgrim of Somerset no oil standing to the Eastward at 8 A.M. tacked to the westward saw white water and tacked to the Eastward it proved to be a fine Dick tacked to the N. S. W. so Ends 1 man sick

Thursday July the 15th. Commences with strong Breezes from the Southward standing to the N. S. W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail equally 2 sail in sight so Ends 1 man sick

Friday July the 16th. Begins with fresh Breezes from the South standing to the N. S. W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail at 9 A.M. spoke the Canama 600 Barrells 200 of it she sent home so Ends 1 man sick

Saturday July the 17th. Commences with fresh Breezes from the South standing to the N. S. W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail wind S. E. heading N. S. W. at 9 A.M. spoke the Barque passed bound to the Eastward so Ends 1 man sick

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Sunday July the 18th. Commences with fresh Breezes from S. E. and clear weather standing to the N. E. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail so Ends equally 1 man sick

Monday July the 19th. Begins with fresh Breezes from the S. E. equally standing to the S. S. W. at 6 P.M. saw Whales down Boats and chased till sun set came aboard and stood to the S. E. at 12 A.M. were to the N. E. at day light made sail at 9 A.M. tacked to the S. S. W. started 1 Barrell of Beef so Ends

Latt By Obs. 32.38 N. Long 46.02 W

Tuesday July the 20th. Commences with fresh Breezes from the S. E. and equally standing to the S. S. W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail at 9 A.M. saw a Breach and Ram for it it was Whales down Boats and struck to the Larders so Ends 1 man sick

Wednesday July 21st. Begins with light Breezes from the S. E. at 2 P.M. took a whale alongside and cutting out the Body in and lay by the head all Night middle part calm heavy swell at day light hove in the head and commenced Boiling water to the westward and made sail so Ends 1 man sick

Thursday July the 22nd. Begins with light winds from the Southward standing to the westward Boiling water. port the same at 7 A.M. tacked to the Eastward so Ends 1 man sick
