Monday August the 2nd Commences with light winds from the Eastward standing to the South at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail so Ends the cook sick

Tuesday August the 3rd Begins with light winds from the Eastward standing to the South at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail at 7 o'clock. Tacked to the Northward started 1 Barrel of Beef so Ends the cook sick

Latt By Obs. 31.08 N Long. 43.56 West

Wednesday August the 4th Commences with light winds from the Eastward variable standing to the Northward at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail at 9 A.M. saw a whale lowered and S. Boat struck so Ends

Latt. 31.30 North

Thursday August the 5th Begins with light winds from the E.S.E. past to a large whale killed him and took him alongside lay by him all Night commenced Boiling so Ends

Latt By Obs. 31.48 N

Friday August 6th Commenced with light winds from the Eastward cutting the head sunk bad so Ends

Latt 32.10 N

Saturday August the 7th Begins with light winds cutting so Ends Began to Boil -- Latt By Obs. 32.33 N

Sunday August the 8th Commences with light winds and variable Boiling wore ship to the Southward latter part to the S.E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 32.52 N

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Monday August 9th 1841 Commences with light winds standing to the Southward Boiling finished Boiling so Ends

Latt By Obs. 32.01 N

Tuesday August 10th Begins with light winds from the Eastward variable middle part the same latter part Employed stowing down so Ends

Latt By Obs 31.16 North

Wednesday August 11th Commences with light winds from the Eastward standing to the Southward Employed stowing down finished stowed down 83 Barrels middle part the same at day light made sail tacked the the N.E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 31.10 N Long 43.40 West

Thursday August the 12th Begins with light winds from the Eastward standing to the N.N.E. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail so Ends

Latt By Obs. 32.06 N Long. 43.15 W

Friday August the 13th Commences with light winds from the N.E. and clear weather standing to the N.N.W. at sun set shortened sail at day light make sail standing to the N.W. so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 32.56 N Long 44.17 W

Saturday August the 14th Begins with light winds variable from E.N.E. to E.S.E. standing to the S.W. at sun set shortened sail and wore ship to the S.E. at day light made sail so Ends one sail in sight

Latt By Obs. 32.45 N Long 44.22 West
