Wednesday September the 8th Commences with light winds from the Northward steering East at sun set shortened latter part stowing down squally so Ends started 1 cask of Bread

Thursday Sept. the 9th Begins with light winds from the N. E squally with a heavy swell on stowing down stowed down 96 Barrells middle and latter part laying to heading to the N. N. W. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 36.36 N Long 36.31 West

Friday Sep the 10th Begins with strong winds from the N. E squally heading to the N. N. W. with a heavy swell laying to under the main top sail and fore spencer middle and latter part the same Employ. setting up the Rigging so Ends

Latt By Obs. 36.38 N Long 37.10 W

Saturday Sep the 11th Commences with strong winds and squally from the N. E lying too heading from N. to N. W. middle part the same latter part moderate so Ends

Latt By Obs. 36.57 N Long 38.09 W

Sunday Sep. 12th Begins with light winds and variable made sail at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail wind from the S. S. E heading to the N. E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 37.01 N Long 37.41

Monday Sep. 13th Begins with light winds and calm weather standing to the N. E at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail steering East one sail in sight one man sick started 13 B. of Beef so Ends

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Tuesday September the 14th 1841 Commences with light winds from the Northward steering East middle part fresh Breeze at day light made sail steering E. N. E so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 37.46 N Long 35.56 West

Wednesday Sep. the 15th Begins with fresh Breezes from the North and clear weather steering E. N. E at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail steering E. N. E so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 38.17 N Long 34.36

Thursday Sep. 16 Commences with light winds and calm weather steering E. N. E. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail calm heading various courses one sail in sight light Breeze from W. N. W steering E. N. E so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 38.13 N Long 33.48

Friday Sep. the 17th Begins with light winds from the W. N. W. steering E. N. E at sun set shortened sail at 12 P. M. took in the T. T. sail and fore sail and close Reef. the Top sail and hove to heading to the N. W. squally of rain and Rain from the N. E latter part the same one man sick so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 38.29 N Long 33.09 West

Saturday Sep the 18th Commences with strong Gales from the E. N. E to N. E. E. laying to heading to the N. W. middle part the same at day light more moderate made sail and wore ship wind from the North standing to the Eastward one sail in sight and one man sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 38.35 N Long 33.00

Sunday Sep the 19th Begins with strong winds from the Northward standing E. N. E at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail at 12 P. M. took in the fore sail strong Gale with a heavy sea so Ends with one man sick
