

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

Friday October the 1<sup>st</sup> 1841 Commences with fresh Breezes from N.W. steering S.E. middle part the same latter part S.E. and South two sail in sight so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 37-13 N. Long 22-50 West

Saturday Oct. the 2<sup>nd</sup> Begins with fresh Breezes from the N.N.W. and clear weather steering South middle and latter part the same so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 35-36 N. Long 21-44 W

Sunday Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup> Commences with fresh Breezes from the N.W. steering South middle part the same at 9 A.M. saw a large sperm whale going to windward Down Boats and gave chase so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 34-12 N. Long 20-49 W

Monday Oct. 4<sup>th</sup> Begins with fresh Breezes from the N.N.W. the Boats in chase of a sperm Whale at 3 P.M. come aboard and kept off South middle and latter part the same 2 sail in sight so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 32-36 N. Long. 20-08 West

Tuesday Oct. the 5<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh Breezes from the N.W. and fine clear weather steering South middle and latter part the same Bent a new fore top sail so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 30-29 N. Long 19-13 West

Wednesday Oct. the 6<sup>th</sup> Begins with fresh Breezes from the N.W. and fine weather steering South at 10 A.M. made the Island of Palma Bearing S.E. steered for the Island one sail in sight at sun set shortened sail and haul. by the wind heading to the westward at 2 A.M. wore to the N.E. at day light made sail and steering S.E. & S for the South End of the Island 2 sail in sight so Ends started 1 Bl. of Flour

Latt. By Obs. 29-08 Long 18-10 West

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Thursday October the 7<sup>th</sup> 1841 Commences with light winds from the N.N.W. steering S.E. & S for the Island of Palma one sail in sight at sun set shortened sail and luffed by the wind heading to the westward at 2 A.M. wore ship to the N.E. at day light made sail steering S.E. & S for the South End of the Island 2 sail in sight so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 28-30 N. Long 17-45 West

Friday Oct. the 8<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds and pleasant weather steering S.E. at 1 P.M. saw the Peak of the Island of Teneriffe at 4 P.M. saw the Island of Ferro at sun set shortened sail light winds and variable at day light made sail and steering for the Island of Ferro at 10 A.M. took altitude found the Chronometer 20 miles to the Eastward so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 27-42 N. Long 17-35 West

Saturday Oct. the 9<sup>th</sup> Commences with light winds from the North. Variable steering various Courses along the Island at 2 P.M. steering S.W. & S middle and latter part the same squally wind from the N.E. so Ends started 1 Bl. of Beef

Latt. By Obs. 26-05 N. Long. 17-50 West

Sunday Oct. the 10<sup>th</sup> Begins with fresh breezes from the N.N.E. steering S.W. & S middle and latter part the same so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 24-00 N. Long 18-27 West

Monday Oct. the 11<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh breezes from the N.N.E. steering S.W. middle and latter part the same bent a new fore sail Employed mending the old fore sail so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 22-12 N. Long 19-55 West

Tuesday Oct. the 12<sup>th</sup> Begins with fresh Breezes from the N.E. steering S.W. at 4 P.M. S.W. middle part the same latter part S.W. so Ends

Latt. By Obs. 20-23 N. Long 20-26 West
