

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

Wednesday October the 13th 1841 Commences with fresh Breezes from the E.N.E. steering S.W. at sun set shortened sail and hauled to the Northward at 12 A.M. wore to the S.E. at day light made sail and steering South Employed Repairing the fore sail one sail in sight so Ends

Latt By Obs. 19. 14 N Long. 20. 35 West

Thursday Oct. the 14th Begins with fresh Breezes from the E.N.E. and thick weather steering South a English ship passed close to steering to the W.N.W. full of Transports at sun set shortened sail and luffed up E.S.E. at day light made sail steering S.S.E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 18. 01 N Long. 19. 47 West

Friday Oct. the 15th Commences with fresh Breezes from the N.E. and hazy weather steering S.W. at sun set shortened sail and hove to head? E.S.E. at day light made sail steering S.W. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 4 1/2 N Long. 19. 10 West

Saturday Oct. the 16th Begins with fresh Breezes from N.N.E. and hazy weather steering E.S.E. at sun set shortened sail and heading to the Eastward at day light made sail steering E.S. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 51 N Long. 18. 01 West

Sunday Oct. the 17th Commences with strong Breezes from N.N.E. and hazy weather steering E.S.E. one sail in sight at sun set shortened sail heading to the E.N.E. at day light made sail and lowered for Black fish we did not get on so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 41 N Long. 17. 55 W

Monday Oct. the 18th Begins with light winds from the Northw. and hazy weather steering W. S. W. saw Black fish and lowered we did not succeed at sun set shortened sail heading to the W. N. W. at day light made sail saw Black fish lowered we did get on saw Black fish and lowered so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 43 N Long. 17. 41 W

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Tuesday October the 19th 1841 Commences with light winds and thick hazy weather in chase of Black fish the Larboard Boat got one come Aboard and stored W. S. at sun Black fish again lowered to wide awake come Aboard and shortened sail and hove to at day light made sail steering W. S. at 12 o'clock latched ship to the E.N.E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 15. 52 N Long. 18. 14 W

Wednesday Oct. the 20th Begins with light winds from the Northw. and thick hazy weather steering by the wind heading E.S.E. and E.N.E. wind variable at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail standing E.N.E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 00 N Long. 17. 38 W

Thursday Oct. the 21st Commences with light winds from the Northward and hazy weather standing E.N.E. at 1 o'clock steered East at sun set shortened sail and wore Round to the W. N. W. at day light made sail and latched to the Eastward so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 02 N Long. 17. 15 W

Friday Oct. 22nd Begins with strong winds from the N.N.E. hazy weather at 12 M. latched to the N.W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail heading E.N.W. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 05 N Long. 18. 30 W

Saturday Oct. the 23rd Commences with light strong Breezes from the N.N.E. standing to the N.W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail standing N.W. light winds one sail in sight so Ends started 1 Barrel of Pork 1 Cask of Bread

Latt By Obs. 16. 20 N Long. 19. 11 West

Sunday Oct. the 24th Begins with light winds from the N.N.E. standing N.W. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail steering W. N. W. some of the crew has stolen a ham and sugar 4 marmalade missing and Paint Brushes 2 hammers so Ends
