

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

Tuesday December the 7th 1841 Commenced with light Breezes from the Eastward variable steering N.W. & N. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail steering N.W. & N. one man sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 4.49 N. Long. 22.25 W

Wednesday Dec. 8th Begins with light winds from the Eastward steering N.W. & N. at sun set shortened sail middle and latter part squally steering S.W. one man sick so Ends
No Observation

Thursday Dec. 9th Comm. with light winds variable squalls of wind and Rain Thunder and Lightning midd and latter part the same one sail in sight and one man sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 4.36 N Long 23.30 W

Friday Dec 10th Begins with thick squally weather with heavy Thunder and lightning steering N.W. wind from N.E. to S.E. at sun set shortened sail heading to the North at day light made sail steering N.W. squally one man sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 4.59 N. Long. 24.08 W

Saturday Dec. 11th Comm. with light winds from the Eastward steering N.W. middle part the same latter part squally steering from N.W. to S.W. at day weather steering N.W. & N. so Ends one man sick Latt By Obs. 5.44 N. Long. 24.44 W

Sunday Dec. 12 Begins with light winds from the Eastward steering N.W. & N. middle part the same latter part North spoke the Cambrian of Boston 12 months out 2000 barrels so Ends

Latt By Obs. 6.35 N Long 25.59 W

Monday Dec. 13th Comm. with light winds from the Eastward standing to the North at sun set tacked to the S. E. middle and latter part the same 3 sail in sight one man sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 6.05 N. Long 25.24 W

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Tuesday December 14th Comm. with light winds from the Eastward and clear weather standing to the S.E. at 10 P.M. tacked to the Northward middle part N.W. at 10 A.M. tacked to the S.E. 2 sail in sight one man sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 6.27 N. Long. 26.04 W

Wednesday Dec. 15th Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward and fine weather standing to the S.E. middle part squally at 2 A.M. tacked to the Northward the Cambrian among whales so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 6.20 N Long 25.48

Thursday Dec. the 16 Comm. with fresh Breezes from the Eastward in Chace of whales at 1 P.M. lowered could not get on going back to windward tacked to the S.E. middle part the same latter part to the Northward so Ends

Latt By Obs. 6.22 N Long

Friday Dec 17th Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward variable tacked to the S.E. at 6 P.M. tacked to the S.E. at 6 A.M. tacked to the S.E. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 6.36 N Long. 26.12 W

Saturday Dec 18th Comm. with fresh Breezes from the Eastward variable standing to the S.E. at 3 squally wore ship and Reef? top sails heading N.W. & middle and latter part the same squalls of wind and Rain with Thunder and lightning wind all round the compass so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 23.35 N

Sunday Dec the 19th Begins with squally variable weather middle part the same latter part moderate Breezes from the S.W. standing to the Northward so Ends one man sick
