Tuesday January the 18th 1842 Commences with light winds from the E.N.E. fine steering West of the Island of Porto Rico at sun set shortened sail of the Dead man's Chest standing to the South at 3 A.M. wore to the Northward at day light made sail saw the Pilgrim 200 Barrells saw Blackfish lowered got Nothing steering Along the Island so Ends

Wednesday Jan. 19th Begins with light winds and fine weather steering various Courses down the Island of Porto Rico at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail saw Blackfish lowered of the America of Warham the Pilgrim and the Cambria Boats down got Nothing so Ends started 1 Barrell of Beef so Ends

Latt By Obs. 18. 01 N Long 67. 40 W

Thursday Jan. the 20th Comm. with light winds steering West the Island of Moona in sight the Cambria in Company saw hump Back. Going Quick at shortened sail to the S.E. at 3 A.M. wore to the North at day light made sail heading for the Island at 8 A.M. saw white water stored for it so Ends

Friday Jan the 21st Begins with fresh Breezes steering from N.N.W. to S.W. in chase of the at 4 P.M. steered west middle part the same latter part W.S.W. at 10 A.M. St. Domingo in sight the Cambria in Company so Ends

Saturday Jan. the 22nd Commences with light trades steering from W.N.W. Along the Island and W.S.W. at 12 A.M. hauled to the Southward at day light made sail steering Along the Island so Ends

Sunday January the 23rd 1842 Commences with light winds steering S.W. Cape Beata and Altavilla Rock in sight at 5 P.M. hauled up N at sun set shortened sail and wore to south at 10 A.M. wore to the North moderate at 8 A.M. made sail heading Northward so Ends

Latt By Obs. 17. 19 N. Long 71. 32

Monday Jan. the 24th Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward and clear standing to the Northward at sun set tacked to the South and shortened sail Altavilla bearing S.E. Dist 3 Leagues middle part moderate at day light made sail and tacked to the N.E. spoke the Pilgrim and the Park Ryan of Edgartown 9 months out 150 Barrells so Ends Corr. 16. 37"

Latt By Obs. 17. 30 N Long 71. 35 West

Tuesday Jan. the 25th Comm. with light winds from the Eastward standing to the N.E. at 1 P.M. tacked to the South at 4 tacked to the N.E. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail fresh Breezes standing off and on so Ends

Wednesday Jan. the 26th Begins with strong winds variable from E.S.E. to N.E. at 3 P.M. come to Anchor in same Bay Santa Mingo the Pilgrim in company several sail in sight middle and latter part light winds so Ends

Thursday Jan. the 27th Comm. with light winds and variable Employed Rattling and tarring the Rigging so Ends

Friday Jan. the 28th Comm. with strong Breezes and variable Employed Rattling the Rigging and Cutting wood so Ends

Saturday Jan. the 29th Begins with strong Breezes and variable Employed Cutting and Boasting off wood
