

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

- Sunday Jan. the 30th 1842 Commences with fresh Breezes from the Eastward middle and latter part variable so Ends 3 men sick
- Monday Jan. the 31st Begins with fresh winds from the Eastward midd. and latter part variable Employed Boating off wood and Rattling the Rigging so Ends 3 men sick
- Tuesday Feb. the 1st Commences with fresh Breezes and variable middle part moderate at day light up anchor and shifted further to the South come to Anchor so Ends 3 men sick
- Wednesday February the 2nd Begins with strong winds from the Eastward 6 Whalemans to Anchor Employed fitting and cleaning ship so Ends the Bark Cornelia of Westport 16 months out 550 Bbls the Bark Emma of do 14 months out 550 Bbls the Elizabeth of do 8 1/2 months 170 and Pilgrim and America no oil since spoken for so Ends 3 men sick
- Thursday Feb. the 3rd Comm. with strong winds from the Eastward Employed painting and Rattling the Rigging so Ends 2 men sick
- Friday Feb. the 4th Begins with strong Gales from Eastward Employed Painting ship and Rattling and tarring the Rigging started 1 Bbl of Beef 1 of Pork so Ends 2 men sick
- Saturday Feb. the 5th Comm. with strong winds from the Eastward finished Painting and Tarring middle part moderate at 9 A.M. 5th under weigh light wind standing to the South squally Reef. top sails and tacked standing in 4 sail in company so Ends 2 men sick

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- Sunday February the 6th 1842 Commences with strong Gales from the Eastward Beating up to the Anchorage at 1 P.M. let go the Anchor middle part light winds latter part strong Breezes so Ends
- Monday February the 7th Begins with strong winds from the Eastward middle and latter part the same so Ends 2 more whalemans come to Anchor one sick man went ashore
- Tuesday Feb. the 8th Comm. with strong winds from the Eastward the Brunette of Falmouth and the Maine come to Anchor middle part light winds at 10 A.M. up Anchor and stood to sea so Ends one man sick
- Wednesday Feb. the 9th Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward standing to the Southward 4 sail in sight at sun set shortened sail laying off and on at day light made sail squally standing in for the Island so Ends one man sick
- Thursday Feb. 10 Comm. with strong Gales from the Eastward standing in for the Island at 3 P.M. let go the Anchor the Pilgrim the Elizabeth the Cambria and Maine come to Anchor 3 sail in the Day beating up to the Anchorage so Ends unbent the M.T. sail to Repair
- Friday Feb. 11th Begins with strong winds Employed Repairing the M. top sail finished the top sail and bent it so Ends one man sick
- Saturday Feb. 12 Comm. with strong Gales from the Eastward middle and latter part the same so Ends
- Sunday Feb. 13th Begins with strong Gales from the Eastward 10 sail at Anchor middle and latter part the same
