Sunday February the 14th 1842 Commences with strong Gale from the Eastward midd part moderate at 7 A.M. up anchor the Pilgrim in Company steering N.W. & W. started 1 Barrel of Flour so Ends 1 man sick

Tuesday Feb. the 15th Begins with light winds and variable steering W.N.W. at sun set shortened sail heading to the Southward at day light made sail steering W.N.W. so Ends 1 man sick

Latt By Obs. 18.00 N Long 72.48 W

Wednesday Feb. the 16th Comm. with light winds from the Eastward steering West at sun set shortened sail heading to the south at 4 A.M. wore to the Northward at day light made sail steering W.b.S. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 18.07 N Long 73.26 W

Thursday Feb. the 17 Begins with light winds steering W.b.S. at sun set Cape Tiberon bore W.N.W. Dist 7 Leagues midd part squally latter part fine weather the Pilgrim in Company so Ends

Latt By Obs. 18.02 N Long 75.00 W

Friday Feb. the 18 Comm. with light winds from the Eastward and Pleasant weather steering W.b.S. midd part the same at day light made Jamaica steering W.b.S. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 17.55 N Long 75.52 W

Saturday Feb. the 19th Begins with fresh trades steering W.b.S. at sun set shortened sail heading to the South at day light made sail steering West lost sight of the Pilgrim so Ends started 1 Bbl of Beef

Sunday February the 20th 1842 Comm. with fresh steering West down & along the Island midd part winds from the Northward variable heading various courses latter part from the N.E. steering N.W. & W. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 18.00 N Long 78.36 W

Monday Feb. the 21st Begins with light winds from the Northward variable steering W.N.W. at sun set Jamaica bore E.N.E. Dist 7 Leagues midd. and latter part light winds so Ends

Latt By Obs. 18.30 N Long 79.31 West

Tuesday Feb. the 22nd Comm. with light winds from the N.E. variable steering W.N.W. midd part calm and variable latter part from the Northward squally close Reef the top sails and furled the F. sail heading from west to S.W. so Ends

No Observation

Wednesday Feb. 23rd Begins with strong Gales from North to N.W. laying to heading from West to S.W. midd part the same at 10 A.M. set the F. sail heading W.N.W. so Ends 1 man sick

Latt By Obs. 18.57 N Long 79.55 W

Thursday Feb. 24 Comm. with strong Gales from N.E. steering W.N.W. middle and latter part west at day light let out the Reefs at 10 A.M. Double Reef the top sails squally steering S.W. so Ends 1 man sick

Latt By Obs. 19.06 N Long 81.50 W

Friday Feb. the 25th Begins with strong winds from the E.N.E. steering S.W. midd part the same at 7 A.M. made swim Island hauled up South so Ends one man sick

Latt 17.20 N Long 84.08 W
