

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

Saturday February the 26th 1842 Commences with light winds from the Eastward standing off and on under the lee of Swan Island at 5 P.M. come to Anchor midd part equally latter part Pleasant saw some Turtle so Ends

Latt By Obs. 17. 24 N Long by Cron. 83. 50 W

Sunday Feb. the 27th Begins with fresh Breezes from the East. Employed setting up the Rigging and fitting the Fore Truss midd part equally at 6 A.M. weighed Anchor and stood to the S.E. so Ends 1 man sick

Latt By Obs. 17. 10 N Long By Cron. 83. 50 W

Monday Feb. the 28th Comm. with light Trades standing to the S.E. at sun set shortened sail at 2 A.M. wore ship to the South at day light made sail one sail in sight so Ends

Latt By Obs. 16. 43 N Long By Cron. 84. 02 W

Tuesday March the 1st Begins with light winds from the East. at 12 M. backed to the N.E. at sun set shortened sail at 2 A.M. wore ship to the South at day light wore to the N.N.E. latter part steering North so Ends two men sick

Latt By Obs. 17. 41 N Long, 83. 44 W

Wednesday March the 2nd Comm. with light winds from the East steering North middle and latter the same so Ends

Latt By Obs. 19. 46 N Long 83. 49 W

Thursday March the 3rd Begins with fresh Breezes from the Eastward and fine weather steering N.N.W. mid part the same at 7 A.M. made the Island of Cuba steered N.W. at 10 A.M. Cape Antonio Bore N.N.W. Dist 3 Leagues started 1 Blk of Beef

Latt By Obs. 21. 54 N Long 84. 48 W

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Friday March the 4th 1842 Begins with fresh Br. the Eastward steering N.N.W. middle and latter part strong winds from the S.E. and squally so Ends 2 men sick

Latt By Obs. 24. 24 N Long 85. 32 W

Saturday March 5th Comm. with strong winds from the S.E. steering North at 3 P.M. N.W. middle and latter part the same so Ends 2 men sick

Latt By Obs. 26. 04 N Long 86. 00

Sunday March the 6th Begins with fresh Breezes from the S.E. steering N.W. at sun set shortened sail heading to the S.W. at day light made sail steering N.N.W. so Ends two men sick passed several pieces of Drift wood

Latt By Obs. 26. 43 N Long 86. 34

Monday March the 7th Comm. with fresh Breezes from the S.E. fine weather steering N.N.W. at sun set shortened sail heading to the S.W. at day light made sail steering N.W. light winds 2 men sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 27. 04 N Long 86. 44 W

Tuesday March the 8th Begins with light winds from the S.E. and fine moderate weather steering N.W. at sun set shortened sail middle part calm latter part light Breeze from the Eastward steering N.W. all sail set two men sick so Ends

Latt By Obs. 27. 08 N Long 86. 41 W

Wednesday March the 9th Comm. with light winds from the East. steering N.W. middle part the same fresh Breeze latter part N.N.W. and west one man sick so Ends 2 sail in sight

Latt By Obs. 28. 07 N Long 87. 26 W
