

Remarks on Board the Brig Leonidas

Sunday March the 21st 1842 Commences with light winds from the Eastward standing to the N.E. at sun set shortened sail at 2 A.M. wore to the S.E. & at day light made sail moderate weather so Ends one man sick & sail in sight spoke the Emigrant of Bristol.

Tuesday March the 22nd Begins with calm moderate weather middle and latter part the same thirteen sail in sight so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 28.17 N. Long 88.36 W

Wednesday March the 23rd Commences with light winds from the W. S.W. standing to the N.W. at sun set shortened sail and wore ship to the South at 2 A.M. wore to the N.E. at day light made sail at 9 A.M. tacked to the S.E. several sail in sight so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 28.27 N. Long 88.43 W

Thursday March the 24th Begins with light winds from Westward standing to the Southward at sun set shortened sail and wore to the W. N.W. at day light made sail and tacked to the Eastward at 7 A.M. tacked to the W.S.W. at 9 tacked to the E.S.E. the America in sight so Ends

Latt By Obs. 28.16 N Long 88.46 W

Friday March the 25th Commences with brisk Breezes from the Southward standing to the E.S.E. spoke the Emigrant saw nothing since we spoke them last middle and latter part calm so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 28.10 N Long 88.30 W

Saturday March the 26th Begins with light winds and variable calm weather middle part the latter part light Breezes from the Northward steering W. b S. started 1 Bull of Beef 1 of Pork so Ends

Latt By Obs. 28.08 N Long 88.37 W

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Sunday March the 27th 1842 Commences with light from the Northward and calm weather steering W. b S. at sun set wore ship to the Eastward and shortened sail steering E. latter part S.E. wind N.E. hazy & sail in sight so Ends

Latt By Obs. 27.47 N. Long 88.42 W

Monday March the 28th Begins with brisk Breezes from the N. steering S.E. and S.S.E. at sun set shortened sail at day light sail standing to the Southward several sail in sight so Ends one sick

Latt By Obs. 26.57 N. Long 87.18 W

Tuesday March the 29th Commences with brisk Breezes from the Eastward standing to the Southward at 4 P.M. spoke the Samuel Thomas of Providence 15 days out nothing at sunset shortened sail and wore ship to the N.E. at day light made sail and wore to the South so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 26.23 N. Long 86.39 W

Wednesday March the 30th Begins with smart Breezes from the Eastward standing to the Southward at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail and wore ship heading S.E. b S. so Ends

Latt By Obs. 25.40 N. Long 87.5 W

Thursday March 31st Commences with fresh Breezes from the E.S.E. standing N.E. and N.N.E. at sun set shortened sail wore ship to the Southward at 12 A.M. wore to the Northward at day light made sail wore to the Southward so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 25.40 N. Long 87.07 W

Friday April the 1st Begins with light winds from the Eastward standing the S.E. at sun set shortened sail at day light made sail so Ends one man sick

Latt By Obs. 24.48 N. Long 86.48 W
