Thursday January the 13

These 24 hrs begins with Light Breezes
From the S.E. Stearing S.S.W. saw 2
veels Middle part Strong winds and
Squally at 6 P.M. saw 3 sperm whales
going very quick to the North East
Loaded and chased them and got
Nothing at 10 P.M. came on board
So ends this day
Lat in 11° 08' S

Friday January the 14/1848

These 24 hrs begins with light
Breezes from the S.E. Stearing S.S.W.
at 4 A.M. took in the topgallandsail
Middle and latter part Strong winds
So ends this day
Lat in 13° 16' S Long in 30° 26' W

1848
Saturday January the 15

These 24 hrs begins with Strong
Breezes from the E.S.E. Stearing South
at 4 A.M. saw blackfish at 5 A.M.
Respect the topsails Middle part Strong
Winds and Squally took in the gip
Latter part more moderate and
Made all sail So ends this day
Lat in 15° 15' S

Sunday January the 16/1848

These 24 hrs begins with Light Breezes
From the E.S.E. Stearing South Middle
and latter part the same all hands
employ'd in Ship duty So
Ends this day
Lat in 17° 00' S Long in 30° 22' W

Monday January the 17th 1848

These 24 hrs begins with light Breezes
From the Eastward with fine wether
Stearing S.S.E. by the wind under all sail
Middle and latter part the the same all
Hands employ'd in Ship duty so ends
this day
Lat in 17° 55' S Long in 29° 50' W

Tuesday January the 18/1848

These 24 hrs begins with light Breezes from
The Eastward Stearing S.S.E. under all
sail and made a new fly gip boom and
Bend the sail Middle part winds from
The E.S.E. Stearing S.E. all Hands emp-
loyed in Ship duty So ends this day
Lat in

Wednesday January the 19th 1848

These 24 hrs begins with Light
Breezes from the eastward Stearing S.S.E.
By the wind bainted the main
and fore mast Middle part fine
Wether at 2 P.M. saw the island of
Martin vas took in the courses and
Laid with the red yards buck
til 5 P.M. Steard to the S.S.E. under
All sail So ends this 24 hrs
Lat in 20° 40' S

Thursday January the 20th 1848

These 24 hrs begins with Light Breezes
From the E.S.E. Stearing S.S.E. saw a
brig Stearing to the Northward Middle
and latter part fine wether So ends
this day
Lat in 20° 51' S
