Sunday February the 13th 1848
These 24 Curs begins with moderate
breezes from the N.W. Stearing
S.E. under all sail Middle and
Latter part the same at 11 P.M.
Saw a Buck So ends this day
Lat in 33° 48' S Long in 01° 01' W

Monday February the 14 1848
These 24 Curs begins with moderate
breezes from the N.W. Stearing S.E.
under all sail Middle and Latter
part the same So ends this day
Lat in 33° 55' S Long in 01° 21' W

Tuesday February the 15th 1848
These 24 Curs begins with strong
breezes from the N.W. Stearing
S.E. under all sail at 5 A.M.
Took in the Main sail and
steared S.E. at 8 A.M. fresh gales
from the S.W. Clost reef the
Topsails Middle latter part more
Moderate Put the gips and main
sail with fresh ends and fine
Weather Stearing S.E. under all sail
So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 34° 32' S

Wednesday February the 16 1848
These 24 Curs begins with strong
breezes from the S.W. Stearing
S.E. under all sail Middle part
strong breezes from the N.W. at 6
P.M. took in the main and fore
Topsail at 10 P.M. run S.E. under
all sail with clost reef topsails
And foresail So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 35° 19' S Long in 06° 47' E

Thursday February the 17 1848
These 24 Curs begins with fresh gales
from the N.W. With heavy sea
At 6 A.M. reef the fore sail fore tops
sail Middle part blowing heavy
from the Westward took in the main
Topsail Latter part more moderate
So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 35° 48' S Long in 09° 46' E

Friday February the 18 1848
These 24 Curs begins with moderate
gales from the West Stearing
S.E. under all sail strong breezes
And S. gale Latter part more
Moderate Struck out the reef out
of the topsail and set out the main
Topsail So ends this day
Lat in 36° 30' S Long in 12° 48' E
