These 24 Ours begins Strong Breezes
And Squally at 3 A.M. Lost reef
Topsail And took in the main Sail
Middle part fresh gales from the S.W.
With heavy Squalls thunder and
Lighten Latter part under close
Reef and fore spencees at 10 P.M. more
Moderate So ends this 24 Ours
Lat in 36° 08' S Long in 141° 14' E

Sunday February the 20 1848

These 24 Ours begins with Strong breeze
from the S.E. Steering E. Lost reef
The topsails lower Middle part
Light Breezes the Westward under
all Sail Latter part Strong breeze
from the N.W. under all Sail
Lat in 37° 17' S Long in 161° 25' E

Monday February the 21 1848

These 24 Ours begins with Strong
Breezes from the N.W. And Squally
at 3 A.M. took in the main Berghallant
at 4 A.M. lost reef the topsails
Middle part Strong Breezes from the
Westward Steering S.E. by S under all
Sail Latter part Light Breezes from
West So ends this day
Lat in 37° 59' S Long in 170° 45' E

Tuesday February the 22 1848

These 24 Ours begins with Light
Breezes from the Westward Steering S.E.
By the wind under all Sail with fine
Weather Middle part Light Breezes from
the N.E. Steering E.S.E. Latter part
Light wither So ends this 24 Ours
Lat in 37° 30' S Long in 180° 08' E

Wednesday February the 23 1848

These 24 Ours begins with Light Breezes
from the N.W. Steering S.E. under all
Sail wither weather Middle and
Latter part Light Breezes from the N.E.
Steering E with 2 Ships in Side So ends this
24 Ours
Lat in 37° 30' S Long in 182° 09' E

Thursday February the 24 1848

These 24 Ours begins with Strong Breezes
from the N.E. Steering E under all Sail
With a Whale Ship in Side and
a Bark Middle part Light Squalls
from the N.W. at 2 P.M. lost reef
The topsails and took in the gaff and
Mainsail at 10 P.M. send down the main
mast and the tregallant yard And took
in the boats on decks And Steered S.E.
Before the wind with all Sail in Latter
part fresh gale with rain and Lighten
So ends this day
Lat in 37° 00' S
