Gale and heavy Squalls at 11 o'clock
Reef the foresail topsails under Close
Haul Middle part more moderate
And set the gip and sheet out
The reef of the topsails and send up
The main ryalmast and tergaland
yard So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 36°40' S Long in 27°25' E

Sunday February the 26th 1848
These 24 Curs begins with Light
Breezes from the Westward Stearing
East Middle part Strong Breezes
Hook in the gip and main sail and
Close reef the topsails and Steard (by)
Latter part fresh gales from the N.W.
And stood before it at 11 o'clock some
Some sail So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 25°30' S Long in 30°06' E

Monday February the 27th 1848
These 24 Curs begins with fresh gales
from the Westward Stearing East
At 3 o'clock more moderate and made
Sail Middle and Latter part Light
Breezes with fine weather Stearing
E by N under all sail So ends this
24 Curs Lat
Lat 34°54' S Long in 32°05' E

Tuesday February the 28th 1848
These 24 Curs begins with Light
Breezes from the Westward Stearing
E by N under all sail at 12 o'clock
in These tergaland sail and main
sail Latter part fresh gales from the
N.W. Stearing E S by the Wind
under Close reef topsails So ends this
24 Curs
Lat in 35°30' S Long in 33°50' E

Wednesday February the 29th 1848
These 24 Curs begins fresh gales from
the N.W. Stearing E by S under
Close sail by the Wind at 4 o'clock
reef the main sail and set it
Middle part wind N.W. by W set
The fore topsail and Steard N.E
Latter part Light Breezes from the
N.W. Steard N.E under all sail
So ends this day
Lat in 34°27' S

Wednesday March the 1st 1848
These 24 Curs begins with Light
Breezes from the N.W. Stearing N.E
under all sail with fine weather
Middle part Strong Breezes Latter
part the same So ends this 24 Curs
