These 24 Curs begins with Strong
Breezes from the E. N. E. Stearing
South at 4 o'clock. Tack Ship and
stead E. N. E. by the Wind at 3 o'clock
Took in the main top gallant sail
at 10 o'clock. A Ship Stearing at 11
P. M. took in a reef in the fore sail
So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 27° 05' S Long by Comanche
43° 05' E Lamer 43° 34' E

Friday March the 11 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong Breezes
from the S. S. E. Stearing East by the
Wind at 1 o'clock. Close kept the topsail
at 2 o'clock. Saw a Bark Stearing too the
Westward at 4 o'clock. Saw a Ship at 6 o'clock
M. Close up the topsail at 10 o'clock
in the gip. Latter more moderate. So ends
this day Lat in 28° 14' S Longitude 43° 46' E

Saturday March the 11 1848

These 24 Curs begins with moderate
gales from the S. S. E. Stearing East
at 2 o'clock. Took in the main sail
upper Ship and stood S. W. by the
Wind. Middle part fresh. Equals
Latter part the same. So ends this
24 Curs
Lat in 28° 49' S Longitude 43° 15' E

Sunday March the 12 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong
Breezes from the S. S. E. Stearing
N. E. at 4 o'clock. Can see up too the
Wind. Middle part the same. Latter
part more moderate and struck the
Reef out of the topsails and put the
Main sail the wind S. W. Stearing
S. E. by E under all sail. So ends this
24 Curs
Lat in 28° 17' S

Monday March the 13 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong Breezes
from the S. W. Stearing S. E. by E Middle
and Latter part the same. So ends this
24 Curs
Lat in 28° 12' S Longitude 45° 15' E

Tuesday March the 14 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light
Breezes, made calm at 6 o'clock. Rose her
Main topsail reef tacked and gip
Hullards. Latter part the same. So ends
this 24 Curs
Lat in 28° 27' S

Wednesday March the 15 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong Breezes
from the S. W. Stearing East by the
Wind. With fine Weather. Middle part
Wind from the S. W. Stearing S. E.
Latter part the same. So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 27° 16' S Longitude 46° 05' E
