These 24 Cues begins with Light

149 Sunday April the 2nd 1848
These 24 Cues begins with Light
Breezes from the S. E. Steering S. W. with
Fine Weather at 3 A.M. wore Ship
and stood Eastward at 6 A.M. took
in the Single reef the topsails at 7 P.M.
Made all Quil and saw a pack So
ends this 24 Cues
Lat by Observation 13° 21' S Long in 51° 53' E

150 Monday April the 3rd 1848
These 24 Cues begins with Light
Breezes from the S. E. Steering N. W.
at 6 A.M. took in the mainsail and
Gill and Single reef the topsails at 11 A.M.
Wore Ship at 6 P.M. made all Sail
and Wore Ship Middle and Latter
part the wind from the South So ends
this 24 Cues
Lat by Observation 12° 49' S Long in 52° 46' E

151 Tuesday April the 4th 1848
These 24 Cues begins with Light breezes
from the South Steering North
at 6 A.M. took in the courses and gill-
And Single reef the topsails at 12
A.M. wore Ship at 6 P.M. made all
Sail and wore Ship Latter part the
same So ends this 24 Cues

152 Wednesday April the 5th 1848
These 24 Cues begins with Light
Breezes from the E by S Steering N. E.
by E with clearest weather at 4 A.M. fired
sh. mnd. the old fore-sail and bend it
Middle and Latter part the same
all hands employed in re-bairing
the old fore sail So ends this 24 Cues
Lat by observation
