SE Steering S S W So ends this 24 Curs

Monday April the 17 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong
Breezes and Squally weather ant saw
Blackfish at 6 A M took in sail for
the Night at 6 P M made all sail middle
And Latter part the same So ends this 24 Curs

Tuesday April the 18 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong Breezes
And fine weather at 6 A M took in sail
for the Night Middle and Latter
Part the same So ends this 24 Curs

Wednesday April the 19 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong
Breezes and Squally weather at 6 A M took
in the Gills and main sail and fore to main
And close reef the main to sail at 6 P M
Foot M latter made all sail at 9 A M

Spoke the bark Montezuma of New
Bedford Captain Allen 18 mms out
350 bbls Sperm oil and the Captain
Came on board of us so ends this 24 Curs

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes
From the E S E with fine weather at 6 A M
Took in sail for the Night with the fore
in Side at 6 P M made sail with all
Hands un-bloyed in Strong town Oil
