a gale and set the gib at 6 took in the  
Gib and trisail at 10 A.M. set the gib and  
trysail at 6 P.M. set the sheet the reef out  
Of the topsails So ends this 24 Cur

Monday May the 8 1848

These 24 Curs begin with Light breezes  
And fine weather at 2 A.M. saw the island  
Of Algebar at 4 A.M. the larboard boat went  
On Shore at 6 A.M. came off again at 7 1/2  
A.M. and 4 P.M. were ship at 8 P.M. the boat  
Went on Shore for wood So ends this 24  
Cur

Tuesday May the 9 1848

These 24 Curs begin with Light breezes  
From the E.S.E. Steering N.E. Spring  
Off and with both boats a Shower for wood  
at 12 Meridan came on board with 2  
Boaty loads So ends this 24 Cur  
Le at in

Wednesday May the 10 1848

These 24 Curs with Light breezes with  
Bland weather at 4 in the Starboard boat  
Went on Shore four turkeys but got worn  
At 6 A.M. the Starboard went on Shore  
Four wood and both boats came on  
board at 7 A.M. reef the topsails 8 P.M.  
Sheet the reef out at 11 P.M. set the  
Main teryalland sail So ends this 24 Cur  
Le at in

Thursday May the 11 1848

These 24 Curs begin with Light breeze  
at 4 A.M. saw a whaling ship to the  
Windward at 6 A.M. the Starboard boat went  
On Shore four turkeys at 11 A.M. came on  
With 5 and went back after 2 more  
at 2 P.M. came on board and stood to the  
South by the wind So ends this 24 Cur

Friday May the 12 1848

These 24 Curs begin with Light breezes  
at 2 A.M. saw the ship Phocion of no  
Bedford Captain Worth 22 months out  
800 bbls of Oil and the Captain came  
On board and the Starboard boat 6 saw  
Went on board of her at 6 A.M. the  
came on board
