Topsails Middle the same at 12 AM
Wore Ship at 6 PM Shuck out the
Reef and let the main sail and wore
Ship So ends this 24 Curs
Lat in 7.47 S Long in 45.33 E

Sunday May the 21 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light breezes
And pleasant weather at 6 AM took in
The main tregallantail at 2 PM wore Ship
at 3 PM wore Ship at 6 PM let the main
tregallantail and wore Ship So ends this
24 Curs

Monday May the 22 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light
breezes From the S.E. Steering S.S.E. by the
Wind under all Sail at 3 AM
Wore Ship Middle and Latter part the
Same So ends this 24 Curs

Tuesday May the 23 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light breezes
From the East Steering S.S.E. by the
Wind with pleasant weather at 9 AM
Wore Ship Middle and Latter part
The same So ends this 24 Curs

Wednesday May the 24 1848

These 24 Curs begins Light breezes
From the E. Steering N.S.E. by the Wind
under all Sail Middle part Strong breezes
Latter part but up the targe and bars
For the Mast boats and gut her of Stern
at 10 AM up with Mast So ends this 24 Curs
With some men of duty Sick
Lat by Observation 7.33 S Long 45.23 E

Thursday May the 25 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light
breezes and pleasant weather Latter
part took the Mast boat in one deck
For repair Saw Nothing So ends
This 24 Curs
Lat in 7.15 S Long 45.30 E

Friday May the 26 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light breezes
And gut through repairing her and cut her
Out on the Crabs Middle and Latter
part the same So ends this 24 Curs
Lat by Observation 7.34 S Long 46.47 E

Thursday May the 27 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes From
The S.E. Steering E by N. by the wind And
Took in the main tregallantail and Clostrup
The topsails Middle part Squally at 6 PM Shuck
out the main topsail and reef and
Tied the try sail boom and ~~shut~~ it So ends
This 24 Curs
