terma So ends this 24 Curs

Sunday June the 4 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes at 1 A.M. Capt. Cornel went on board of her at 4 A.M. a boat from them arrived from our wind on Shore for wood at 7 A.M. came off with paid of a load at 8 A.M. that boat went on Shore for turkeys at 6 P.M. the Loadboard boat went on Shore for wood and the east boat went a boater with nothing at 8 P.M. she came on shore for wood So ends this 24 Curs

Monday June the 5 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes at 5 A.M. boats came on board with wood Middle and latter part the same So ends 24 Curs

Tuesday June the 6 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes at 1 A.M. the boat went on Shore for turkeys at 11 A.M. came off with 6 Middle and latter part the same So ends 24 Curs

Wednesday June the 7 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes at 8 A.M. reef the topsail at 10 A.M. took in the gib and main sail and try sail at 6 P.M. took in the fore sail and so reefed too call them down from a loft
So ends this 24 Curs

Thursday June the 8 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes from the S. by E Stearing S. by W and set the fore sail and stood mast beat a game in Curmbury with 1 Whaler So ends this 24 Curs

Friday June the 9 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes from the S. by E Stearing S. by W at 4 A.M. were Ship Middle and latter part more moderate at 6 P.M. made all sail at 8 P.M. were Ship a 11 Tack Ship So ends this 24 Curs

Saturday June the 10 1848

These 24 Curs begins with Light breezes and made all sail and send the Steward foredeck and took a notice with 4 Whalers in Side at 11 A.M. took in the gib and main sail and reefed the topsails So ends this 24 Curs
