The English Ship sailed Middle part the Sail
All hands employed in Ship duty So
Ends this 24 Curs

Tuesday July 11th 1848

These 24 Curs begins with blund weather
And all hands employed in backing out
And getting of water and 2 visits in Sea
So ends this 24 Curs

Wednesday July 12th 1848

These 24 Curs begins with blund weather
With all hands employed backing out
And getting of water at 12 A.M. the Ship
came to anchor at 10 P.M. the Draper
came to anchor So ends this 24 Curs

Thursday July 13th 1848

These 24 Curs begins with fine weather and
All hands employed in backing out
And Storing down So ends this 24 Curs

Friday July 14th 1848

These 24 Curs begins with fine weather and
All hands employed in Storing down
So ends this 24 Curs

Saturday July 15th 1848

These 24 Curs begins fine weather at 6 A.M.
But through Storing down at 7 A.M. saw
a Sail and the Starboard watch went on
Shore for liberty So ends this 24 Curs

Sunday July 16th 1848

These 24 Curs begins fine weather and Sat 3 A.M.
The Clarice of New Bedford came to anchor
And the Starboard watch went on Liberty
So ends this 24 Curs
