

Wednesday August 9<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with Light breezes  
from the S S W Steering S S W under all  
Sail So ends this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 8° 35' S Long 46° 05' E

Thursday August 10<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with a Strong breeze  
at 6 A.M. in fly gib and topgallantail at 6 took  
in the main sail and lost reef the topsail  
12 A.M. put the main sail so ends this  
24 Curs

Friday August 11<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes  
from the south steering E S E by the wind  
at 5 P.M. send down the try sail to repair  
So ends this 24 Curs

Saturday August 12<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes  
at 2 A.M. put the gib and main sail at 4  
A.M. bend the try sail at 7 A.M. and bend  
the fore sail to repair so ends this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 6° 00' S Long 47° 54' E

Sunday August 13<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with a Strong breeze  
from the S S W Steering East at 4 A.M.  
bend the fore sail Middle part light breezes  
and at 6 P.M. make all sail at 10 P.M. took in  
the fly gib and lost reef the topsails so ends  
this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 5° 46' S Long 47° 08' E

Monday August 14<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with strong breezes  
from the S S W Steering E by N  
and struck the reef out and at the main topgallant  
tail at 4 A.M. took it in Middle and  
Latter part the same so ends this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 4° 57' S Long 50° 25' E

Tuesday August 15<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes  
from the South steering E S E Middle  
part squally so ends this 24 Curs

Wednesday August 16<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with Strong breezes  
from the S S W Steering N E at 2 A.M.  
Send down the main topgallant tail  
to repair Latter part the same so ends  
this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 2° 36' S Long 53° 14' E

Thursday August 17<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with fresh breezes  
from the S S W Steering S by W at 2 A.M.  
Saw a sail to the wind at 4 A.M. spoke  
the Marcella of New Bedford so ends  
this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 00° 57' S Long 52° 57' E

Friday August 18<sup>th</sup> 1848  
These 24 Curs begins with fresh breezes from  
the S S W Steering N by W in bumbag  
With the Marcella Blasted the yards and  
stood on the wind so ends this 24 Curs  
Lat by Observation 00° 05' S Long 53° 06' E
