

Wednesday September 6th 1849

These 24 Curs begin with Light breeze and fine
Weather and at 10 A.M. catch a Rooper and 6 P.M.
Saw Black fish and Chisthena till 7 and got
Nothing so ends this 24 Cur
Lat by Observation 8° 00' N Long 69° 00' E

Thursday September 7th 1849

These 24 Curs begin with Strong breeze and took
in the main topgallantail and single reef the
Topsails and at 6 A.M. cast reef them and took in
the 6 oars Middle part usually and at 6 P.M. set the
6 oars and struck a reef out of the topsails and saw
Limbeck's so ends this 24 Cur
Lat by Observation 8° 29' N Long 70° 53' E

Friday September 8th 1849

These 24 Curs begin with Strong breeze from
the West and steering by N with squally weather
and Middle and latter part the same so ends this
24 Cur
Lat by Observation 8° 11' N Long 73° 00' E

Saturday September 9th 1849

These 24 Curs begin with Strong breeze from and
at 1 A.M. saw Black fish and Lo. and for them and
got Nothing and saw a English merchant ship
from London and at 6 A.M. saw the island of
Minicoy bearing N.E. distance 24 miles and cast
reef the topsails and at 6 P.M. made all sail so ends
this 24 Cur
