

Tues. Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup> 1903

This day gentle breeze from N.E. & fine weather running S.W. with square yards. mainsail furled. saw nothing

so ends this day.

Wed. Feb. 4<sup>th</sup>

This day gentle breeze from N.E. & fine weather running S.W. with square yards. saw nothing untill Four Top mast stay sail & repaired it & bent it again. Lat 26-50. Lon 46-40

so ends this day.

Thurs. Feb. 5<sup>th</sup>

This day light air from S.E. & calm untill 7:00 & repaired them & bent them again. made gibbs cask for beef. saw Black fish Lat 27-30. also saw a steamer bound S.W.

so ends this day.

Friday Feb. 6<sup>th</sup>

This day fresh breeze from South & rough but clear. called down mast heads at 10 A.M. saw a steamer bound S.W. at 8 A.M. more ship & stood to Eastward under short sail all day & night

so ends this day.

Sat. Feb. 7<sup>th</sup>

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather at 8 A.M. bore ship & stood to Westward. at 4-30 P.M. more ship & stood to S.E. under short sail saw a steamer bound N.E. opened cask Bread & Beef. Lat 28-03.

so ends this day.

Sunday Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather first part latter part quite a small raising more ship to W.S.W. at 7 A.M. more back at 5 P.M. saw a white water called it Krampus also saw a Fantask Lat 28-02

so ends this day

Monday, Feb. 9<sup>th</sup> 1903

First & middle part of this day gentle breeze from S.E. & equally. latter part at 6 P.M. wind struck from East & fine weather hauled down try sail & set mainsail. got no observation steering S.S.W. at sunset.

so ends this day.

Tues. Feb. 10<sup>th</sup>

This day first part light breeze from East & fine weather. latter part more breeze. saw 5 shoals of Black fish also saw a white water but never saw it again. saw seven steamers Lat 29-36. Lon 48-00. repaired stay sails

so ends this day.

Wed. Feb. 11<sup>th</sup>

This day gentle breeze from N.E. to N.W. & fine weather steering S. by W. first part then S.W. by S. saw two Barke. one going North the other going with us. Lat 32-00. Lon 48-30. saw Juniper. Brucking.

so ends this day.

Thurs. Feb. 12<sup>th</sup>

This day fresh breeze from N.W. & rough & smoky weather. At 12 noon raised a large sperm whale. close to ship worked up to him & lowered at 4-30 P.M. raised boat fastened killed whale while taking him a long side parted from him lowered down two boats but could not do anything with him so came on board. at 1 P.M. Lat 33-57 Longitude boat got stove Lon 49-45

so ends this day.

Friday Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>

This day light breeze from East & fine weather steering S.W. repaired starboard boat & got rigged for Whaling. saw a steamer bound N.E. Lat 34-26.

so ends this day.
