

Sat. Feb. 14th 1903

Flour First part of this day light breeze from off the land with heavy rain with Thunder & light rain latter part fine weather wind East - broke out cask. Flour. & took out 2 1/2 bbls filled both tanks with water. got no Observation saw Spurn Grampus
so ends this day.

Sunday, Feb. 15th

This day gentle breeze from North & fine weather running S.W. with all sail out saw nothing Lat-36-08. at sunset wind hauled aft - took in headsails & stay-sails

so ends this day.

Monday, Feb. 16th

First part of this day fresh breeze from N.W. with heavy squalls. latter part wind S.W. fresh & clear. under very short sail. built blubber room opened. Mollasses for crew. Lat-37-39 saw nothing

so ends this day.

Tue. Feb. 17th

First & middle part of this day gentle breeze from N.E. & fine weather but heavy swell from S.W. latter part fresh breeze from S.W. took in all sail but lower Topsail & Main stay-sail & Fore Top mast stay-sail & set Top-sail. Lat-38-31

so ends this day.

Wed. Feb. 18th

First & middle part of this day stiff breeze from S.W. & clear. latter part calm. at 7 A.M. commenced to make sail. saw a Bark. bound with us. Lat-39-03. Lon 58-47

so ends this day.

Thurs. Feb. 19th 1903

This day strong breeze from N.W. & smoky weather, stiring S.W. until sunset then wind hauled to S.W. fresh put under short sail. Lat-39-43. saw some White-water also a spout called it Finbacks.

so ends this day.

Friday Feb. 20th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather cruising with all sail out saw some Finbacks at sunset took in sail & laid to Southward

so ends this day.

Sat. Feb. 21st

This day calm all day until 4:30 P.M. then breeze up. North & fine carried sail all night - saw nothing set up Top. Gallant-rigging & fitted bottom. Keel. Lat-38-50 Lon 58-09

so ends this day.

Sunday, Feb. 22nd

This day gentle breeze from N.W. all day & fine weather saw nothing at 8 A.M. sounded & found 50 fathoms water kept off S.W. by S. at sunset took in sail & hauled a back. to fresh Lat-39-49

so ends this day.

Monday Feb. 23rd

This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather running S.W. saw nothing put up. Crowns. Keel. Lat-40-36.

so ends this day.

Tue. Feb. 24th

This day fresh breeze from N.W. first part & fine weather latter part S.W. more ship at sunset & stood to Westward. saw Porpoise & saw some fed. Lat-41-38. Lon 58-55 stood first-regular Mast-head.

so ends this day.
