

Friday Mch. 20th 1903

This day gentle breeze from West & fine weather all day. Cruising with all sail out - saw nothing. Flushed water & filled both tanks.

so ends this day.

Sat - Mch 21st

This day fresh breeze from West & clear all day. Run to S.E. part of day, then breezed up & laid too. saw Porpoises Lat-43-50 Lon 60-47

so ends this day.

Sunday. Mch 22nd

This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather all day. at 8 A.M. sounded & found 55 fathoms of water. run off to the Eastward all day. at sunset brought too & found 62 fathoms water. saw nothing Lat-45-07

so ends this day.

Monday. Mch 23rd

This day fresh breeze from North & hazy all day. at 8 A.M. sounded & found 65 fathoms water then run off N.E. until noon & sounded 90 fathoms & no bottom. saw several Finbacks & Porpoises. Lat-44-15 Lon 59-13

so ends this day.

Tuesday. Mch 24th

This day gentle breeze from North & foggy weather all day. saw some Finbacks. got no observation at sunset breezed up from South & cleared up.

so ends this day.

Wednesday. Mch 25th

First part of this day gentle breeze from N.W. fine weather. latter part fresh. saw 2 schools Porpoises. Lat-44-50 cruising with all sail out. Molasses for crew. opened cask of Bread

so ends this day.

Thursday. Mch 26th 1903

This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather saw nothing cruising with all sail out. sent down Main Topmast stay sail to repair it. Lat-45-28.

so ends this day.

Friday Mch 27th

This day strong breeze from N.W. & clear until 4-30 P.M. then took a squall from S.E. with heavy breeze at sunset. quite moderate & fair weather Lat-44-56. Lon 60-12. saw nothing

so ends this day.

Sat - Mch 28th

This day fresh breeze from S.W. & clear but a heavy swell did not stand mast head. Lat-43-53. at sunset wore ship & headed the sea.

so ends this day.

Sunday. Mch 29th

This day light air from N.W. & fine weather made all sail at 7 A.M. & stood to S.W. saw a Finback. also a Steamer bound N.E. at sunset took in sail Lat-43-30. heavy swell running from S.E. W.

so ends this day.

Monday. Mch 30th

This day strong breeze from N.W. clear & rough saw some Finbacks. opened Sugar & Flour. cruising under short sail Lat-43-54 at sunset wore ship & laid to Southward

so ends this day.

Tue Mch 31st

This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather all day cruising under all sail saw several Finbacks. Flushed mainmast Lat-43-28.

so ends this day.
