

Wednesday April 1st 1903

This day gentle breeze from North + fine weather all day. cruising with all sail out. saw Finbacks every where all day. saw lots Porpoises spinnited skip out side. Lat 43-35 at sunset run to meal mard. carried upper Topeail all night so ends this day.

Thurs April 2nd

This day gentle breeze from North + smoky all day. cruising to S.W. all day. saw Finbacks + Porpoises. Lat 43-54 - Lon 60-15 saw a Bark bound S.W. so ends this day.

Friday April 3rd

First part of this day. thick Fog + fresh breeze from North at 8 A.M. cleared up. so stood mast head but still hazy. saw a Finback cruising under short sail. at sunset hauled a back + tried for fish but caught none. Lat 44-10 Lon 61-30

so ends this day.

Sat April 4th

First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. + fine weather latter part rainy + nasty run to S.E. all day under all sail saw a Finback Lat 44-43.

so ends this day.

Sunday April 5th

This day gentle breeze from N.W. + fine weather all day. cruising with all sail out saw a Finback, cow + calf. some Porpoises + a Steamer bound N.E. Lat 44-33

so ends this day.

Monday April 6th 1903

This day gentle breeze from West + fine weather cruising with all sail out all day. saw a Bark bound south. filled both tanks with water opened H.L. Mollasses. At 3 A.M. Sebastian Alameda + Apurnard Smith got in a fight + Smith stabbed Alameda in the back + cut Alameda's hand with a knife intent to kill Lat 44-16 caught some fish

so ends this day.

Tuesday April 7th

This day light air from East + fine weather cruising with all sail out all day. saw some Killers + a Steamer bound N.E. Lat 43-49 at sunset took in sail + caught some fish

so ends this day.

Wednesday April 8th

This day gentle breeze from West + fine weather all day. saw Porpoises + struck one but lost him saw a fire masted ship square rigged on all fire mast bound to the Southward Lat 43-10

so ends this day.

Thurs April 9th

All this day gentle breeze from N.W. + fine weather run off the edge of the bank saw lots of Herring backs. Fin backs. + Porpoises got three Porpoises + struck 6 more but none hauled out. saw a ship + set pignale to her. Lat 42-46

so ends this day.

Friday April 10th

This day gentle breeze from North + fine weather cruising with all sail out saw Finbacks + Porpoises got one Porpoise Lat 42-23 started W by S all day. at sunset took in sail

so ends this day.
