

Sat April 11th 1903

First part of this day gentle breeze from North + rainy weather. latter part more fresh + clearer. cruising under short sail saw some Porpoises stood to westward all day got no Observation

so ends this day.

Sunday April 12th

This day gentle breeze from N.E. + rainy weather first part latter part wind S.E. + thick saw nothing caught lots of fish got no Observation

so ends this day.

Monday April 13th

This day strong breeze from South + rough at sunset commenced to moderate called lookout down at 9 A.M. saw a small schooner bound N.N.E. at sunset Lat 41-16 Lon 59-40

so ends this day.

Tuesday April 14th

This day gentle breeze from South + fine weather all day. cruising with all sail out. carried sail all night steering East. saw some Finbacks Lat 40-41

so ends this day.

Wed April 15th

This day light breeze from S.E. + very fine weather all day. cruising with every thing out saw lots of Porpoises + Killers also saw two Steamers bound N.E. at noon tacked ship + stood to S.S.W. Lat 40-19

so ends this day.

Thurs April 16th 1903

This day gentle breeze from N.E. + fine weather run to Southward all day. saw a Finback + Killers. saw a Steamer bound North Lat 40-53

so ends this day.

Friday April 17th

First part of this day gentle breeze from N.E. + rainy weather latter part fresh + clear. under short sail all day saw a Finback Lat 41-18

so ends this day.

Sat April 18th

First + middle part of this day gentle breeze from N.E. + fine weather latter part calm + foggy saw some Finbacks + Porpoises Lat 41-41 caught lots of fish

so ends this day.

Sunday April 19th

This day strong breeze from South + rainy first part. stood no Mast head. under short sail at 2 P.M. wore ship + laid to Eastward Lat 41-29

so ends this day.

Monday April 20th

This day strong breeze from South + fine weather cruising under short sail saw nothing Lat 41-08 Lon 57-45

so ends this day.

Tues April 21st

First part of this day calm middle + latter part fine breeze + fine weather made all sail + run S.W. by S. saw a Finback filled Molasses Keg for crew Lat 40-58 carried sail all night caught lots fish

so ends this day
