

Sat May. 2nd 1903

Whale. This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather at 9 A.M. raised a whale to windward made all sail & tried to work up to him but went out of sight. Boiling all day. At 5 P.M. raised two whales. But did not lower. Lat 42-27 so ends this day.

Sunday May 3rd

This day strong breeze from N.W. & fine weather first part latter part quite rough. finished boiling at 4-30 P.M. Lat 42-30. saw some Finbacks.

so ends this day.

Monday May 4th

This day strong breeze from N.W. & cloudy first part latter part S.W. & more fresh saw several Finbacks stord no Mast heads. Lat 42-17 couldnt stow down oil so ends this day.

Tue. May 5th

Flour & Oil. First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. & rainy weather latter part wind N.W. & clear saw lots of Finbacks. Steered S.W. all day Lat 41-58. filled Mollasses Keg. for crew opened Hbl Pork

so ends this day.

Wed. May 6th

Flour & Oil. This day gentle breeze from N.W. & fine weather. broke out the hole pumped. cask. & stowed down ~~oil~~. Broke out ^{cask} Flour. also Mollasses for crew. saw lots of Porpoises Lat 41-58.

so ends this day.

Thurs. May 7th

This day gentle breeze from West & fine weather cruising with all sail out saw some Finbacks pumped fresh water & fleeted it aft & filled up with salt water stowed off the hole Lat 42-23 - Lon 57-15

so ends this day.

Friday May 8th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather all day. cruising with all sail out saw lots of Finbacks. filled all the empty cask forward of main hatch with salt water & stowed off the hole Lat 41-47. carried sail all night

so ends this day.

Sat May 9th

This day strong breeze from N.W. & rough stord no Mast head after 10 A.M. saw a Finback & Porpoises. laid to Westward all day under short sail parted rope on jib. Lat 42-09 fleeted boats on upper cranes

so ends this day.

Sunday May 10th

First part of this day calm & fine weather but heavy squall from S.W. latter part gentle breeze from S.W. & fine saw two Finbacks & Porpoises. Lat 42-19 Lon. 58-49

so ends this day.

Monday May 11th

Bread This day strong breeze from S.W. & clear. cruising under short sail. saw some Finbacks. opened cask of Bread. Lat 42-21. at sunset wind dying out.

so ends this day
