

Tuesday May 12th 1903

This day gentle breeze from W.S.W. & smoky, cruising with all sail out saw some Finbacks & Porpoises. Lat 42-14. carried sail all night standing to Southward.

so ends this day.

Wed. May 13th

This day strong breeze from S.S.W. to S & cloudy under short sail after 8 A.M. stood no masthead saw lots of Porpoises. Lat 42-03 laid on Port tack all day.

so ends this day.

Thurs. May 14th

First & middle part of this day light air from S.E. & cloudy. latter part gentle breeze from N.E. & still overcast. saw lots Porpoises. Lat 42-01.

so ends this day.

Friday May 15th

This day strong breeze from N.N.W. & cloudy with a heavy swell from S.E. sounded at 8 A.M. & found 60 fathoms water stood to Eastward. until noon under short sail then wore ship to W.S.W. saw lots Porpoises got thru. Lat 43-07.

so ends this day.

Sat May 16th

This day gentle breeze from N.N.W. & hazy weather. at 8 A.M. made all sail & stood to N.S.W. saw lots of Finbacks & Porpoises saw some Killers. cleaned the bone & stored it away in the hold. carried sail all night

so ends this day.

Sunday May 17th 1903

This day light air from E.N.E. & foggy run to westward. saw some Finbacks Lat 42-54.

so ends this day.

Monday May 18th

First & middle part of this day gentle breeze from N.N.W. & foggy but very smooth. latter part clear & fine. under short sail all day. filled all the empty casks on second tier aft with salt water. saw a Fin back Lat 42-58. Lon 60-00.

so ends this day.

Tues. May 19th

This day gentle breeze from N.N.W. & foggy all day run off to Southward all day. saw nothing got no Observation. at sunset hauled to & shortened sail Mollasses for crew

so ends this day.

Wed. May 20th

This day gentle breeze from N.N.E. at daylight made all sail & stood to Eastward shut down foggy & lasted until 2-30 P.M. then shut down again at sunset. got no Observation.

so ends this day.

Thurs. May 21st

This day gentle breeze from North & thick fog until noon. then clear until sunset then rain saw some Finbacks & Porpoises got no Observation sounded & found 63 fathoms water

so ends this day
