

Sunday, May 31st / 1903

This day comes in with strong breeze from N.N.E. with rain. middle & latter part more moderate with fog under short sail said. At noon buried Frank Brita, the other men still sick. sounded & found 55 fathoms water.

so ends this day.

Monday, June 1st

This day strong breeze from North & rain with heavy Thunder & lightning At 5 A.M. Joseph King Reese, died of Berri Berri. The other seamen down sick. saw a steamer, bound S.W. sounded at 4 P.M. got no bottom. wore ship & stood to westward.

so ends this day.

Tuesday, June 2nd

First & middle part of this day wind North with heavy rain. latter part wind South with heavy sea. saw lots of Porpoises sounded & found 70 fathoms water. buried Joseph King Reese at 8 A.M.

so ends this day.

Wed. June 3rd

This day comes in with a gale from S.E. & raining At 9 P.M. commences to moderate, but still heavy sea, saw a Bark. laying to, on Starboard tack, 4 men sick, forward. at midnight wind S.W. & clear & quite moderate. Mr. Jenson & mate taken sick

so ends this day.

Thurs. June 4th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather broke out shoes & stocking for crew. At 2 P.M. Peter Alves, died buried him at 5 P.M. the other men sick Manuel Antonio Gomes Manuel Antonio Geraldo. Markes Mendes. started for Montevideo

so ends this day.

Friday June 5th / 1903

This day gentle breeze from N.N.W. & fine weather at 8 A.M. made all sail & run E by N. at sunset look in sail. saw some Finbacks. Lat 41-34 fourth mate & crew a little better.

so ends this day.

Sat June 6th

This day gentle breeze from North & fine weather saw some Finbacks & Porpoises. Made all sail at 8 A.M. fourth mate much better. crew about the same. Cook taken sick. Lat 41-27. Lon 54-30. At 2 P.M. wore ship & stood to westward. At 7 P.M. Manuel Antonio Geraldo died so ends this day.

Sunday, June 7th

This day gentle breeze from N.N.W. & fine weather under all sail standing N.E. At 7-30 A.M. hauled aback & buried Manuel Antonio Geraldo saw a ship bound with me. Lat 40-52. fourth mate well.

so ends this day.

Monday, June 8th

First part of this day wind N.W. & fair weather latter part strong breeze. at 2 P.M. commenced to shorten sail. at 4-30 P.M. made up to go to St. Helena. so kept off & set upper topsail steering East. Lat 39-53. Lon 53-18 crew better. Cook still sick so ends this day.

Tues. June 9th

First & middle part of this day strong breeze from N.W. & clear. latter part more moderate steering to N.E. with everything set, at 5 P.M. furlled main sail. Lat 37-55. Lon. 49-56. Mollasses for crew.

so ends this day.
