

Sunday, June 21st 1903

This day light breeze from N.N.W. + fine weather steering East with every thing out that would draw. Lat 36-48 Lon 32-10

so ends this day.

Monday, June 22nd

First part of this day fine breeze from North + fine weather. latter part strong breeze from N.W. at 3-30 P.M. took in every thing but lower Top sail + fore + main staysails + laid too at 7 P.M. kept off to east + set bit. at 9 P.M. set Fore sail + upper Top sail. fine weather + strong breeze. at 11-30 set Top. Gallant sail Lat 36-14. Lon 29-45

so ends this day.

Tue. June 23rd

This day comes in with strong breeze from N.W. + clear. latter part wind North + moderate with light rain. steering East with every thing out Lat 35-34. Lon 26-40.

so ends this day.

Wed. June 24th

All this day gentle breeze from N.N.E. + fine weather. steering E. by S. with every thing out saw Killers. Lat 35-15. Lon 24-10 took turned too. fluted water. filled tanks

so ends this day.

Thurs. June 25th

This day gentle breeze from N.N.E. + fine weather steering East with every thing out saw some Fintacks. Lat 34-56. Lon 20-00

so ends this day.

Sperm whales

Friday June 26th 1903

This day gentle breeze from N.N.E. + fine weather steering E. by N. with all sail out. saw some Fintacks. sold the dead seamen's clothes at Auction. Lat 34-09. Lon 17-25

so ends this day.

Sat June 27th

This day fresh breeze from N.N.E. with rain squalls at 4 P.M. took in sail. too reefed. Mainsail furled. Top sail. steering E. by N. Lat 33-32 Lon 14-25.

so ends this day.

Sunday, June 28th

This day gentle breeze from N.N.E. + fine weather steering E. by N. with all sail out. saw some Fintacks. Lat 32-55 Lon 12-20.

so ends this day.

Monday, June 29th

This day gentle breeze from N.E. + fine weather steering E. by S. with all sail out. saw some Fintacks opened. Flour. + Molasses. 1 Hl. At 11-30 P.M. John Fortie a seaman died Lat 32-12 Lon 10-08. four other seamen sick off duty

so ends this day.

Tue. June 30th

This day gentle breeze from N.E. + fine weather steering E. by S. with all sail out. At noon buried John Fortie the other men no better Lat 32-44. Lon 7-24.

so ends this day.

Wed. July 1st

This day light airs from N.N.E. + fine weather Lat 32-02. Lon 0-00. saw nothing

so ends this day.
