

Thurs. July 2nd / 1903

This day light air from N.N.E. + fine weather
steering E.N.E. saw nothing Lat 31-21
Lon 4-20 started to scrape spare. 4 seamen
still sick

so ends this day.

Friday July 3rd

First part of this day gentle breeze from North
+ fine weather latter part calm. crew busy scraping
spare. Lat 30-46. Lon 4-08. crew about
the same.

so ends this day.

Sat July 4th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. + fine weather
running N.N.E. saw nothing crew about the
same. Lat 30-15. Lon 3-38

so ends this day.

Sunday July 5th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. + rains squalls
running N.N.E. with all sail set. saw a
Fin back. Lat 28-54. Lon 3-43.

so ends this day.

Monday July 6th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. + squally
steering North with all sail out.
At 6:30 P.M. Pedro. Catalano. a seamen
died Lat 26-53. Lon 4-30 washed
Bone.

so ends this day.

Tuesday July 7th

This day gentle trades + squally steering
N.E. by N. with all sail out. Bent new Flying
jib. buried Pedro. Catalano. at 7-38 A.M.
the other men about the same. Lat 24-43
Lon 4-45.

so ends this day.

Wed. July 8th / 1903

This day gentle trades from S.E. + fine weather
steering N.E. by N. with every thing set started
to scrub ship. Lat 22-25. saw nothing
crew about the same. fire off duty.

so ends this day.

Thursday July 9th

This day gentle trades from S.E. + fine weather
steering N.E. by N. finished washing ship
crew improving. Lat 20-03. Lon 4-31.

so ends this day.

Friday July 10th

This day gentle trades + fine weather steering
N.N.E. saw some Porpoises. Lat 17-30 Lon 4-20
opened cask of Bread. crew about the same.

so ends this day.

Sat July 11th

This day gentle trades from S.E. + fine weather
At 2:45. kept off N.W. At 7 A.M. sighted
St Helena. straight ahead. distant 50 miles
anchored at 7 P.M. furled sails. + set anchor
watch.

so ends this day.

Sunday July 12th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. + fine weather
laying at St Helena under Quarantine

so ends this day.

Monday July 13th

This day gentle trades from S.E. + fine weather
At 7 A.M. turned to + washed. Fore castle. came
out of Quarantine at 3 P.M. took 4 seamen
on shore to Hospital. Mark. Mendez, Manuel
Antoni Gomez, Manuel Tique. Joseph Britta
sent storeward watch on shore at 5 P.M.
opened sugar.

so ends this day.
