

Monday, Nov. 16th 1903

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. At 1 A.M. tacked & stood to S.E. until 3 P.M. then tacked to westward. Land on weather bow. Anna bonne distant 20 miles. Broke out between decks forward & washed it out. saw Porpoise struck but one but lost it. Mate still off duty.

so ends this day.

Tues Nov. 17th

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather. stood on Port tack all day to N.W. saw nothing. mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Wed. Nov. 18th

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather. stood to N.W. all day. with all sail out. saw Porpoise & got one. filled fore hole on second tier with salt water. mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Thurs. Nov. 19th

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather. steering N.W. all day. saw nothing. Mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Friday Nov. 20th

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather. steering N.W. all day. saw a Finback. Mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Sat. Nov. 21st 1903

This day fresh breeze from South & fine weather. standing close haul on Port tack all day. saw nothing. Mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Sunday, Nov. 22nd

This day fresh breeze from South & fine weather. stood close haul on Port tack all day. at 5 P.M. took in Main Topmast staysail Jib Top sail & Main Gaff Top sail & furlled them. Lat 5-08 Lon 4-17 West. Mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Monday, Nov. 23rd

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. steering on the wind on Port tack with every thing out - but Main Gaff Top sail saw two Steamers bound S.E. Mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Tuesday, Nov. 24th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather on Port tack close hauled all day. with all sail out saw a Steamer bound S.E. saw a Finback & Porpoise got one. Mate off duty.

so ends this day.

Wed. Nov. 25th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather. stood on Port tack until noon then wore around. until 4 P.M. then came around on Port tack, set up. Fore Rigging both sides & Back stays. saw nothing. Lat 8-05 Lon 7-05 Mate off duty.
