

Tuesday Dec 8th 1903

First part of this day, calms at 10 A.M.
breeze up from N.N.W with rain, cleared
up, at noon, & died out. at 3 P.M. hauled to
West. Lat 23-32. at sunset steering S.E. &
with every thing set.

Wed Dec 9th

This day gentle breeze from N.E. & fine weather
steering S by E. unbent Foresail & repaired it
& bent it again. saw a Sulphur bottom cow-calf
saw Porpoise. Lat 23-49.

Thurs Dec 10th

This day light air from S.E. & fine weather
steering S by W. saw a Finback unbent
Flying jib & repaired it & bent it again
Lat 24-30. Lon 12-30

Friday Dec 11th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
steering S by W. saw nothing, repairing old
jib.

Sat Dec 12th

This day light air from N.E. & fine weather
steering S by E. saw nothing finished
repairing old jib & bent it at sunset
calm.

Sunday Dec 13th

This day light air from N.E. & fine weather
steering S by E. saw Porpoise Lat 26-42
at sunset wind North & very light

so ends this day.

Monday Dec 14th 1903

First & middle part of this day, light air from S.E. &
latter part S.E. & more fresh fleeted boats on
second fleet. at 11 A.M. raised a large. White
water long way off on Starboard bow. at 3 P.M.
raised it a gain close to it proved to be
a Finback. Broke out water Pork & Sugar

so ends this day.

Tues Dec 15th

This day very light air from East all day.
saw nothing Lat 27-12 Lon 11-00.
at 5 P.M. furled mainsail. wind N.N.E. light
with heavy smell from S.W.

so ends this day.

Wed Dec 16th

This day light air from N.W. & fine weather
steering S by E. saw Grampian Porpoise &
a Finback. Lat 27-33.

so ends this day.

Thurs Dec 17th

First part of this day, gentle breeze from S.W.
& fine weather middle & latter strong breeze
from South with heavy rain squalls.
At 10 A.M. furled. Topm Mast sail jib Topm
& Main Top mast staysail at sunset
& reefed Mainsail & furled upper Topsail
steering S by E. Lat 28-06

so ends this day

Friday Dec 18th

This day strong breeze from South with a
nasty sea. but clear weather steering S by E
at 7 A.M. set upper Topsail & turned out
one reef of Mainsail stood no mast heads
Lat 27-12 Lon 8-23.

so ends this day
