

Wednesday Dec 30th 1903

First part of this day light breeze from S.E. & cloudy with light rain latter part South & fine steering E by S. saw lots Porpoises. caught a large A. bicore & lots Dolphin
Lat 13-50 Lon 14-30

so ends this day.

Thurs. Dec 31st

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather steering E by S. all day saw nothing
Lat 13-26 Lon 7-26

so ends this day & year.

Friday Jan 1st

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather. At day light whale close to ship got boats ready & lowered. Starboard boat fastened. other boats chased off. Waist boat got Mr. & Row boat one got along side at 2-30 with last whale. Put up gear & started cutting got Mr in at sunset. set watch at 7-30 P.M. Lat 13-10 Lon. 8-35

so ends this day.

Sat Jan 2nd

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather latter part S.W. At day light more ship & hooked on to whale all in at 7-30 A.M. cut up head & randed. blubber started fire at 10 A.M. finished boiling head at 7 P.M. Lat 12-59 saw nothing but Porpoises

so ends this day.

Sunday Jan 3rd

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather. Boiling all day. saw nothing Lat 13-01
so ends this day.



Monday Jan 4th 1904

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather pumped water & fluted at aft. stored down oil & washed off. At 5-45 P.M. raised whale on weather beam 3 miles off. to late to lower
Lat 12-50 Lon 10-00

so ends this day

Tuesday Jan 5th

First part of this day gentle breeze from S.E. & & hazy weather latter part S.W. & fine & moderate laid to N.N.W. until 8 A.M. then wore ship to S.E. saw nothing opened Reef & Flow & busy washing clothes

so ends this day.

Wed. Jan 6th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather At day light raised whale a head 1 1/2 miles off got boats ready & lowered. Starboard boat fastened whale jammed. saved. & lost two after they were raised. got a long side at 2-30 P.M. put up gear & cut two whales set watch at 7 P.M. Lat 13-10 Lon 10-59 Starboard Boat killed four.

so ends this day.

Thurs. Jan 7th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather at daylight hooked on to whale all in at 12-30 cut up head & randed blubber started fire at 2 P.M. set watch at 6 P.M. at 4 P.M. saw a large white water twice saw nothing after Lat 13-10

so ends this day.

Friday Jan 8th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather. Boiling all day. at 8 A.M. saw a white water but saw nothing after at 4 P.M. looked ship & stord S.W. westward Lat 13-08 Lon 11-00

so ends this day
