

Sat Jan 9th / 1904

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather finished boiling at noon. cleared up. decks saw nothing at sunset latched ship & stood S.E. with all sail out Lat-13-10 Lon 10-35

so ends this day.

Sunday Jan 10th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & very fine weather. at 8 A.M. latched ship & stood to S.E. with all sail out saw nothing Lat-13-30

so ends this day.

Monday Jan 11th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather pumped cask & shifted water & stowed down oil stood to westward all day. latched ship at ^{set} sunset saw nothing Lat-13-56. Lon 10-00

so ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 12th

Park This day strong breeze from S.W. & fine weather stood on Starboard tack all day at sunset latched ship & took in Jib Top-sail. saw nothing Lat-14-12. Lon 11-00. opened Beams & Port-cum-bury making stowage

so ends this day.

Wed. Jan 13th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & cloudy & hazy all day. saw nothing stood to S.E. until sunset then latched off shore. Lat-14-37 Lon 11-35 caulked try works.

so ends this day.

Thurs. Jan 14th / 1904

First-part of this day light-air from S.W. & cloudy. latter part West clearing by the wind on Starboard Tack. saw nothing Lat-14-37. opened slope for crew.

so ends this day.

Friday Jan 15th

This day gentle air from S.W. & cloudy first-part latter part fine breeze from West. at 8 A.M. sighted the land. on lee bow. at sunset Fish Bay bore East distant 10 miles latched ship & laid off shore. saw Porpoises nothing else.

so ends this day.

Sat Jan 16th

First-part of this day very light-air from S.W. & fine weather latter part nice breeze from West-land in sight all day. saw nothing. At day light stood in shore. at sunset latched & stood off shore. scrubbed ship out side.

so ends this day.

Sunday Jan 17th

This day gentle breeze from West & fine weather at 1 P.M. sighted & still it proved to be Bark Grayhound. gammed with to get the men. land. in sight 35 miles south of Fish Bay at sunset took in sail & laid to

so ends this day.

Monday Jan 18th

This day first part light-air from S.W. & fine weather latter part nice breeze saw nothing Bark Grayhound in sight. cleaned ship forward. shifted Jib Top-sail & all the Main Stay-sails. at 4 P.M. latched & stood off shore.

so ends this day.
