

Tue. Jan 19th 1904

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather
gammed Bark. Morning Star one other Bark
in sight saw Porpoises & two Fairbacks.
Lat 15-48

so ends this day.

Wed. Jan 20th

First & middle part of this day calm & fine weather
latter part gentle breeze from S.W. at 3 P.M. tacked
& stood to S.E. Bark. Morning Star in sight at 6 P.M.
saw a large White whale, about four miles off,
about the same time the Bark tacked & laid
to, came on dark, so could not tell if she had
whale. Lat 16-05. Lon 9-50. sent down Top
Gallant sail & repaired it

so ends this day.

Thurs. Jan 21st

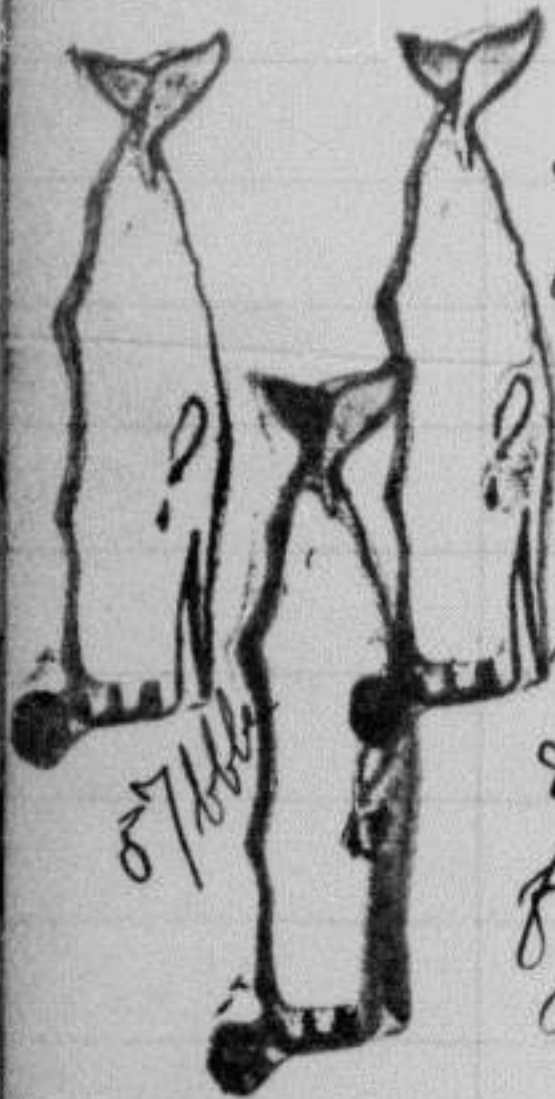
This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather
At 7-30 A.M. raised a White whale on lee bow
& 4 miles off. run off to North at 12-30 noon
raised whale close to ship lowered & waist
boat fastened whale gammed Bow boat
& Starboard boat fastened got a long side & made
fast at sunset took in sail & set watch at 7-30
P.M. Lat 16-18 Lon 10-00

so ends this day

Friday Jan 22nd

This day light air from S.W. & calm. At daylight
put up gear & hooked on to whale all in at 9-30 A.M.
sent down gear cut up the whale randed all the blubber
& started fire at 11 A.M. at 3-30 P.M. sighted a dead
whale. lowered & took him a long side put up
gear & cut him in all in at 7 P.M. secured
head. & set watch at 8-45 Lat 16-09 Lon 10-13

so ends this day



Sat Jan 23rd 1904

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather
boiling all day. one Bark in sight at noon
kept off & run N.W. at sunset took in light
sails. Lat 16-09 opened Flour John George
so ends this day.

Sunday Jan 24th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather
finished boiling at 1 A.M. gammed Bark Morning
Star. Lat 16-08 Lon 9-56.

so ends this day.

Monday Jan 25th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & hazy all day slowed
down Oil one Bark in sight saw nothing else.
at sunset hauled up. Fore sail & laid to S.E.

so ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 26th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather
at daylight made all sail & stood to N.E. & W.
until noon then tacked to S.E. one Bark
in sight. saw lots of Porpoises Lat 16-19
Lon 9-45

so ends this day

Wed. Jan 27th

This day gentle breeze from South & smoky.
one Bark in sight at 6 P.M. raised whale
close to ship coming to windward lowered
& Starboard boat fastened whale gammed
& all four boat got a whale. got a long side
& made fast at 9-30 P.M. took in sail
& set watch Lat 16-10 Lon 10-23

so ends this day.
