

Thurs. Jan 28th 1904

This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather at daylight put up gear & hooked on to whales. all in at noon cut up heads & started fire at 3-30 P.M. Lat-15-50 gammed Bark. Sunbeam.

so ends this day.

Friday Jan 29th

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather stood by S.W. until noon the stood to S.W. to saw nothing finished boiling at 7 P.M. Lat-15-35

so ends this day.

1/4 Rice

Sat Jan 30th

This day gentle breeze & fine weather gammed Bark. Greyhound. Lat-15-31 at sunset took in sail.

so ends this day.

Sunday Jan 31st

This day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather one sail in sight in the morning saw nothing else. Carried sail all night

so ends this day.

Monday Feb. 1st

First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. & fine weather latter part strong breeze stored down Oil. & stored off the hole. saw bon. Fish & Porpoise at sunset looks in sail.

so ends this day.

Tues Feb. 2nd

This day gentle breeze from South & hazy weather. at 7 A.M. made all sail & stood N.W. all day. saw nothing got no Observation at sunset latched to Eastward

so ends this day

Wed Feb. 3rd 1904

First part of this day gentle breeze from S.W. & cloudy. latter part strong breeze from South saw nothing at sunset shortened sail & bro reefed Mainsail Lat-16-02 Loon 10-21

so ends this day

Thurs Feb 4th

This day fresh breeze from S.W. & clear all day. at daylight begun to make sail at noon everything set but Jib Topsail & Staff Topsail saw a Finback. Lat-15-58 at sunset latched & stood off shore land about 25 miles off.

so ends this day

Friday Feb 5th

This day strong breeze from S.W. & smoky. made all sail at daylight & stood in shore sighted the land at noon stood in until 3-30 P.M. then stood land 3 miles off. found our Chronometer 15 miles out to Eastward saw a Bark. saw a Finback. Lat-16-08. at sunset took in sail opened Sugar.

so ends this day.

Sat Feb 6th

This day strong breeze from S.W. & clear all day at daylight made all sail & stood to Westward at noon kept off North. saw a Whaling Bark at 5 P.M. raised a spout called it Finback saw Grampus. Breaching saw Porpoise. Lat-15-54. at sunset took in light sail & furled Mainsail. running North

so ends this day
