

Wednesday Feb 17th 1904

Blane This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
At 4 A.M. John George, a seaman, died of
an unknown disease at 10 A.M. hauled
a back & buried two other men sick
started for St. Helena. Lat-10-24 Lon-8-42
saw Black fish & Porpoise.

so ends this day.

Thurs. Feb 18th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
heading N.N.W. to West all day. with every
thing set. saw Porpoise. washed & flumi-
gated the Fore castle & stowage. Lat-10-05
Lon 6-55

so ends this day.

Friday Feb 19th

Bread Flour 36 1/2 This day gentle breeze from South & fine weather
steering S.W. by W. saw nothing sighted
Fore castle & stowage. Lat-10-50 Lon 5-42
three men on sick list

so ends this day.

Sat Feb 20th

This day gentle trade from South & fine
weather. steering W.S.W. all day. with every
thing set. saw a Steamer bound S.E.
opened cask. Bread & cask. Flour Lat-11-24
Lon 4-42 the sick men much better

so ends this day.

Sunday Feb 21st

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
steering W.S.W. all day saw nothing
Lat-12-08. Lon 3-00 crew much better
so ends this day.

Monday Feb 22nd 1904

Green whale This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
steering W.S.W. with all sail out. At 5 P.M.
raised two large whales on weather bow 3
miles off. going to windward. saw them
2 more rising before sunset. worked to
windward all night. also saw a Steamer
the same time Lat-13-06 Lon 1-00

so ends this day.

Tues Feb 23rd

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
At 7 A.M. lashed ship & kept W.S.W. saw nothing
Lat-13-44 Lon 0-48 East

so ends this day.

Wed Feb 24th

This day gentle breeze from S.E. & fine weather
steering W by S. saw nothing Lat-14-38
Lon 1-00 West. only 1 man sick & he better

so ends this day.

Thurs. Feb 25th

This day gentle air from S.E. & fine weather
steering West all day. sent up Royal yard
& bent Royal. scraped & slushed. spare.
saw two schools Blackfish

so ends this day.

Friday Feb 26th

This day light air from S.E. & fine weather
steering West. saw Steamship washed ship
inside Lat-15-20 Lon 3-35 filled both
tanks with water

so ends this day.

Sat Feb 27th

This day very light air from S.E. & fine weather
At 10-20 A.M. sighted St. Helena. bearing
W by N distant 70 miles took up chains
& bent them. saw Black fish & Porpoise
at sunset. and 50 miles off running
for it

so ends this day.
