days. To have Liberty discharged Henry
Peter Second Officer

so ends this day.

Wed nes day Mch 2nd

This day light air from S. E. & fine weather
one watch a shore on Liberty. 7 seamen
deserted Charles. Bennett, Charles Bennett
Jr. Edward. Price John Johnson T. Adams
William Charles. Peter James Benjamin
Capt. Ellis went home to day so ends this day.

Thurs. Mch 3rd

This day gentle breeze from S. E. & fine
weather. at 1-30 P.M. started to get under
weigh at 5 P.M. proceeded to sea with 23 men
all told & 1st storage. steering N.N.W.
in charge of Mate

so ends this day.

Friday Mch 4th

This day light air from S. E. & fine
weather running N.N.W. Lat-15-26
one Barb a merchant man in company
with us.

so ends this day

This day gentle breeze from S. E.
& fine weather steering N.N.W. with
Maineail furled. Lat-14-12 Lon 7-35

so ends this day.

Sunday Mch 6th

This day light air from S. E. & fine weather
running N.N.W. Lat-13-06. Lon 9-01

so ends this day.

Monday Mch 7th

This day very light air from S. E. & fine weather
steering N.N.W. saw lots of Porpoise nothing else.
Lat. 12-18. Lon 10-12. rose off near St. Helena
shells.

so ends this day.

Tuesday Mch 8th

This day light air from S. E. & fine weather
running N.N.W. with every thing set
saw nothing Lat 11-20 Lon 11-11

so ends this day.

Wed. Mch 9th

This day gentle breeze from S. E. & fine
weather running N.N.W. saw nothing
Lat-10-20 Lon 12-17. at noon took in
Maineail & furled it.

so ends this day.

Thurs Mch 10th

This day gentle breeze from S. E. & fine
weather running N.N.W. by N. saw a
ship bound with us. Lat-9-24.
Lon. 14-04. saw nothing else.

so ends this day.
