

Found two stowaways on board. Broke out / coiled
 Gerald Blackman & Manuel Lopez in manila rope for washing ship.

Put 1 1/2 lbs. flour in pantry. (back for trading) (1/2 pint)

Saturday, April 9th. 1904

Moderate trades today got all hands aboard and are ready for sea. at 5 P.M. Capt. came on board. gave up going tonight.
 So Ends.

Sunday, April 10th.

Variable weather today squally for most part. at 6:30 A.M. got away from Carlisle Bay. two men who shipped have not shown up. steered N.W.W. close hauled. at 11 A.M. hauled up 1/2 pt. to N.W. at 4:30 P.M. saw St. Lucia, at 6 saw Martinique bearing N.W. saw one schooner.

So ends.

Monday April 11th.

Moderate trades well to E. today. at daylight Dominica about 20 mi. distant. kept off for Portsmouth, came to an anchor in eight fathoms water. found here bark Bertha & schooners Golden City, Cleud, Swift & Adelia Chase.

So ends this day.

Starboard watch ashore after supper until 10 P.M.

Started a barrel of beef

Started one barrel beef for trading, veg. & fruit.

Tuesday 12th.

This day comes in calm with rain squalls later breezing up & during the day wind all around the compass. at daylight hove up anchor & warfed nearer to watering place. Joe Maria deserted during the night. crew employed in after hold getting casks to send for water. anchor in 12 fathoms water.

So ends this day.

Wednesday 13th.

Moderate all day. sent empty casks on shore, filled them all & towed three aboard. star port watch on shore this evening.

So ends this day.

Thursday 14th.

Moderate winds, without rain. crew employed getting water. J. Hoyle has not got on board having been ashore without leave since 6:30 A.M. put J. A. Jensen (fourth mate) off duty for being drunk. ~~using~~ Chas. Dossel hurt his ankle in getting water & is now unable to walk. J. Hoyle came on board at 8 P.M.
