

Wednesday April 27th. 1904

Light winds & dry hot weather. Starboard Port watch ashore on liberty with exception of Simon & Barker who overstayed their time yesterday & the men shipped at Barbados. Mapp, Lawrence Adams & E. Jackson. at 9 P.M. Schr. Friedrich Roemer anchored in the bay, bringing provisions & to take our oil.

So ends this day

Thursday Apr. 28th

Moderate weather & dry. got water from shore, set up & flagged casks, got nine bbl. potatoes from F. Roemer, 18 cases canned goods / box soap & one box clothing. Starboard watch ashore for evening. So ends this day.

28th J.A. Jensen on board, on port duty.

Friday Apr. 29th.

Fresh breezes today, dry. employed setting up & shooing & flagging casks. Took two hundred barrels of oil on deck & got it ready to ship. found one cask of 375 gallons leaked out. hoops on one end rusted out. all other casks came out in good condition. watch ashore for the evening.

So ends this day.

Found 2 of a barrel had potatoes in the same barrels. Very good!

Started one barrel beef.

Saturday April 30th. 1904

Fresh breezes today, employed getting out one hundred barrels oil. stowing on one side (port) got casks from shore filled oil. watch ashore for twenty four hours from 6:15 P.M. today.

So ends this day.

Sunday May 1st.

Strong trades today starboard watch ashore on liberty today. squally with small rain. All officers on shore for the day to come on board at 6 P.M. at 8 P.M. gave the ship chain - 60 fathoms to windlass. Chas. Dasset taken with fever temperature 101 at 5:30 P.M. pulse 100. gave physick & nitre. So ends this day.

Monday May 2nd.

Wind died away about 3 A.M. raining. at 5:30 A.M. hove short. got breakfast at 6:30 then hove up & hauled along side the schr. F. Roemer. put 34 casks of oil on board. Harry Broadway & H. Stevens did not come on board today.

So ends?

John Anderson ashore for the evening all others on board.
