

May 3rd. 1904

Squally today. Transhipped 17 casks oil. 4 more in hold. B. Dasset improving. Taitt has cold & sore throat.

So ends.

May 4th. 1904

Moderate breezes today finished putting oil & bone on board the Frederick Rossmore. 67 casks oil & 18 bundles bone (1150 lb.). 575 lbs. oil took casks from shore, filled salt water. at 4 P.M. let go from the schooner and dropped the starboard anchor. 45 fathom shackle under water. Put watch ashore for the evening.

B. Dasset improving. Taitt better. both off duty.

So ends this day.

May 5th.

Pleasant weather moderate winds from various quarters. Capt. left for Roseau at 9 A.M. on the steamer Yare took one cord of wood from beach also got water. Taitt improving. Officer from Portsmouth came aboard & 7 P.M. arrested John Branch for procuring a bottle of liquor unlawfully on shore. watch ashore for the evening.

A. R. Tucker arrived today 5:50 P.M.

So Ends.

Brought 1 1/2 lbs. flour.
J. A. Jensen went to Roseau
with Capt.

J. A. Jensen discharged
today sick.

Started one M. P. dog
"and" to lead
Bike out from engine

May 6th. 1904

Fine weather A.M. P.M. showers. employed getting water & stowing lower hold. steward did not come on board. watch ashore for the evening. J. Branch sentenced to 3 mo. in jail. So Ends.

May 7th.

Fine weather, small showers at long intervals. took one cord wood from beach. also water. Capt. returned on S.S. Yare at 11:30 A.M. had police put Steward on board. B. Dasset about well. Taitt on duty. watch on shore for the evening.

So ends.

Sunday, May 8th

Moderate with occasional squalls some rain. put watch ashore for the day & evening. officer ashore Capt. on board.

So ends this day.

Monday May 9th.

Moderate with rain squalls. employed getting water & wood. (took two cords) repairing casks. B. Dasset on duty. Greyhound got under way at 4:30 P.M. Mr. Wheeler off duty foot swollen & chafed. So ends this day.
