Wednesday Augth 10
Commenced with late N.W. winds
and smothery within the ship standing
on different tracks the middle port fine
breeze at 6.45 PM spoke the Shores
Maria the latter part of the day the
weather the same hands employed in
general work so ends

4.30 AM sent down the cutting pennant
and put a new lashing on the old one was
put up at 7 commenced to cut at 5.15 raised

up the case and got ready to bale it but
the case but did not get any oil at 9 AM
started the works the latter part squally
so ends
