Commences with a fine breeze from the S.W. the ship heading E.S.E. at 7.30 raised Whales at 8.30 and the L.B. S.B. W.B. at 9.30 the S.B. struck at 11 took the whale along side and sent the W.B. and B.B. for a whale at 11.30 the W.B. struck at 5 P.M. took the whale along side and stowed the oil down the latter part of the day fine weather so ends

Friday Sep th 2

Commences with fine weather the wind S.W. at day life commenced to cut at 10 A.M. started the works at 8 P.M. stop cutting having taken one whale and the body of the whale the latter part of the day the weather fine so ends

Saturday Sep th 3

Commences with fine weather the wind from the S.W. still abiding at 7 P.M. took on and took up the head and gale in the small of 4 P.M. finished cutting and made sail and kept the ship E.S.E. the wind from W.N.W. the latter part the ship lying aback so ends

Sunday Sep th 4

Commences with a little S.W. wind still abiding the ship lying aback on the port tack the middle part the weather the same the latter part the wind from the S.W. the ship lying aback so ends

Monday Sep th 5

Commences with a fine breeze from the S.W. the ship lying aback on the starboard tack still abiding at 2 P.M. kept the ship E.S.E. and made sail at 12 noon finished briling and closed up and stowed down part of the oil the latter part the weather the same so ends

Tuesday Sep th 6

Commences with a fine breeze from the S.W. the ship heading E.S.E. at 11.30 A.M. kept her E by S the middle and latter part the weather the same hands employed in stowing down so ends

Wednesday Sep th 7

Commences with a fine breeze from the S.W. the ship heading E by S the middle part the weather the same at 3.30 raised a whale at 4.15 and the L.B. S.B. W.B. and chased till dark with out getting any the latter part the weather the same hands employed in general work so ends

Thursday Sep th 8

Commences with a fine breeze from the ship heading E by S under all sail at 10 A.M. kept her E.S.E. the middle part of the day the weather the same the latter part the wind from the S. hands employed in breaking out so ends

Friday Sep th 9

Commences with a fine breeze from the S the ship heading E.S.E. the middle part of the day the weather the same at 12 noon kept her S.E. by E at 4.30 P.M. raised Whales and the L.B. S.B. W.B. at 5 the S.B. struck at 6.30 took the whale along side the latter part the wind from the S. hands employed in washing ship so ends
